16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:	
17	That §61-8C-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,	
18	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:	
19	ARTICLE 8C. FILMING OF SEXUALLY EXPLICIT CONDUCT OF MINORS.	
20	61-8C-3. Distribution and exhibiting of material depicting minors	
21	engaged in sexually explicit conduct prohibited;	
22	penalty.	
23	Any person who, with knowledge, sends or causes to be sent, or	

24 distributes, exhibits, possesses or displays, or transports any 25 material visually portraying a minor engaged in any sexually

1 explicit conduct, or who receives not less than five hundred items 2 of such materials, for a first offense, is guilty of a felony and, 3 upon conviction thereof, shall be imprisoned in the penitentiary, 4 a correctional facility, not more less than two nor more than ten 5 years, and fined not more than \$2,000, or both fined and 6 imprisoned, with no probation during that term. Any person who 7 violates the provisions of this section and has been previously 8 convicted of any sexual offense or previous violation of the 9 provisions of this section, is guilty of a felony and, upon 10 conviction thereof, shall be imprisoned in a correctional facility, 11 not less than five nor more than fifteen years, and fined not more 12 than \$10,000, or both fined and imprisoned, with no probation 13 during that term.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is add criminal offense of receiving materials depicting minors in sexually explicit conduct and to enhance the felony criminal penalty.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
