10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
13 bedding and upholstered furniture.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia,  
16 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR BUREAU OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE**  
18 **LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-10-1. Division of Labor.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the  
21 thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under  
22 the authority of section fifteen, article one-a, chapter forty-  
23 seven, of this code, modified by the Division of Labor to meet the  
24 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and

1 refiled in the State Register on the twenty-first day of December,  
2 two thousand twelve, relating to the Division of Labor (bedding and  
3 upholstered furniture, [42 CSR 12](#)), is authorized.

5 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of  
6 Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Bedding and  
7 Upholstered Furniture.
