21	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the first
22	day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under the authority

24	modified by the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional
25	Nurses to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review
26	Committee and refiled in the State Register on the seventh day of
