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L 0	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$16-50-2$ of the Code of West Virginia,
L1	1931, as amended, relating to removing an adult family care
L2	home from the definition of a facility for the purposes of the
L3	Medication Administration by Unlicensed Personnel Act.
L 4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
L 5	That $\$16-50-2$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
L 6	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
L 7	ARTICLE 50. MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION BY UNLICENSED PERSONNEL.
L 8	§16-50-2. Definitions.
L 9	As used in this article, unless a different meaning appears
20	from the context, the following definitions apply:
21	(a) "Administration of medication" means:
22	(1) Assisting a person in the ingestion, application or
23	inhalation of medications, including prescription drugs, or in the
24	use of universal precautions or rectal or vaginal insertion of

- 1 medication, according to the legibly written or printed directions
- 2 of the attending physician or authorized practitioner, or as
- 3 written on the prescription label; and
- 4 (2) Making a written record of such assistance with regard to
- 5 each medication administered, including the time, route and amount
- 6 taken. However, for purposes of this article, "administration"
- 7 does not include judgment, evaluation, assessments, injections of
- 8 medication, monitoring of medication or self-administration of
- 9 medications, including prescription drugs and self-injection of
- 10 medication by the resident.
- 11 (b) "Authorizing agency" means the department's office of
- 12 Health Facility Licensure and Certification.
- 13 (c) "Department" means the Department of Health and Human
- 14 Resources.
- 15 (d) "Facility" means an ICF/ID, assisted living, behavioral
- 16 health group home, private residence in which health care services
- 17 are provided under the supervision of a registered nurse. or an
- 18 adult family care home that is licensed by or approved by the
- 19 department.
- 20 (e) "Facility staff member" means an individual employed by a
- 21 facility but does not include a health care professional acting
- 22 within the scope of a professional license or certificate.
- 23 (f) "Health care professional" means a medical doctor or
- 24 doctor of osteopathy, a podiatrist, registered nurse, practical

- 1 nurse, registered nurse practitioner, physician's assistant,
- 2 dentist, optometrist or respiratory care professional licensed
- 3 under chapter thirty of this code.
- 4 (g) "ICF/ID" means an intermediate care facility for
- 5 individuals with an intellectual disability which is certified by
- 6 the department.
- 7 (h) "Location of medication administration" means a facility
- 8 or location where the resident requires administration of
- 9 medication or assistance in taking medications.
- 10 (i) "Medication" means a drug, as defined in section one
- 11 hundred one, article one, chapter sixty-a of this code, which has
- 12 been prescribed by a duly authorized health care professional to be
- 13 ingested through the mouth, applied to the outer skin, eye or ear,
- 14 or applied through nose drops, vaginal or rectal suppositories.
- 15 (j) "Registered professional nurse" means a person who holds
- 16 a valid license pursuant to article seven, chapter thirty of this
- 17 code.
- 18 (k) "Resident" means a resident of a facility.
- 19 (1) "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Department of
- 20 Health and Human Resources or his or her designee.
- 21 (m) "Self-administration of medication" means the act of a
- 22 resident, who is independently capable of reading and understanding
- 23 the labels of drugs ordered by a physician, in opening and
- 24 accessing prepackaged drug containers, accurately identifying and

- 1 taking the correct dosage of the drugs as ordered by the physician,
- 2 at the correct time and under the correct circumstances.
- 3 (n) "Self-administration of medication with assistance" means
- 4 assisting residents who are otherwise able to self administer their
- 5 own medications except their physical disabilities prevent them
- 6 from completing one or more steps in the process.
- 7 (o) "Supervision of self-administration of medication" means
- 8 a personal service which includes reminding residents to take
- 9 medications, opening medication containers for residents, reading
- 10 the medication label to residents, observing residents while they
- 11 take medication, checking the self administered dosage against the
- 12 label on the container and reassuring residents that they have
- 13 obtained and are taking the dosage as prescribed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to remove adult family care homes from the definition of a facility, and therefore coverage, under the Medication Administration by Unlicensed Personnel Act.
