| 21 | (a) Only firefighters and security guards who are members of |
| 22 | the West Virginia National Guard may be employed by the Adjutant |
| | General as firefighters and security quards: Provided. That any |

- 3 may continue to be employed as a firefighter: Provided, however,
- 4 That no person who is not employed on the effective date of this

- 8 (b) Any firefighter employed by the West Virginia Air National
- 9 Guard who, after six years of military service with the West

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow West Virginia National Guard firefighters to become civilian firefighters for the West Virginia Air National Guard.
