12 A BILL to amend and reenact article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of  
13 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
14 Athletic Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating  
15 to mixed martial arts.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

17 That article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
18 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 **ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE**  
20 **LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

21 **§64-7-1. Athletic Commission.**

22 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the  
23 twenty-seventh day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under  
24 the authority of section three-a, article five-a, chapter twenty-  
25 nine, of this code, modified by the Athletic Commission to meet the  
26 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and

1 refiled in the State Register on the eighteenth day of October, two  
2 thousand twelve, relating to the Athletic Commission (mixed martial  
3 arts, [177 CSR 2](#)), is authorized.

5 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Athletic  
6 Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Mixed  
7 Martial Arts.
