23	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
24	twenty-second day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under

the authority of section six, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty,
of this code, modified by the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists
to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review
Committee and refiled in the State Register on the twenty-ninth day
of January, two thousand thirteen, relating to the Board of Barbers
and Cosmetologists (operational standards for schools of barbering
and beauty culture, 3 CSR 4), is authorized.
