

Senate Bill No. 227

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced February 20, 2013; referred to the Committee on
Government Organization; and then to the Committee on the
Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a
legislative rule relating to the operational standards for
schools of barbering and beauty culture.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
twenty-second day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under

1 the authority of section six, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty,
2 of this code, modified by the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists
3 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review
4 Committee and refiled in the State Register on the twenty-ninth day
5 of January, two thousand thirteen, relating to the Board of Barbers
6 and Cosmetologists (operational standards for schools of barbering
7 and beauty culture, [3 CSR 4](#)), is authorized.

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9 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
10 Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule
11 relating to the Operational Standards for Schools of Barbering and
12 Beauty Culture.
