23 **§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.**

24 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the

1 thirtieth day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under the
2 authority of section four, article two-b, chapter forty-nine, of
3 this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources
4 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review
5 Committee and refiled in the State Register on the fifteenth day of
6 January, two thousand thirteen, relating to the Department of
7 Health and Human Resources (minimum licensing requirements for
8 residential child care and treatment facilities for children and
9 transitioning adults in West Virginia, [78 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

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11 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department
12 of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule
13 relating to Minimum Licensing Requirements for Residential Child
14 Care and Treatment Facilities for Children and Transitioning Adults
15 in West Virginia.
