22	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
23	thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under
24	the authority of section six, article eight, chapter thirty, of

this code, modified by the Board of Optometry to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on the fourteenth day of December, two thousand twelve, relating to the Board of Optometry (continuing education, 14 CSR 10), is authorized.
