

1 performing ski patrol or while transporting an injured or ill
2 person to a place for transfer to an available emergency medical
3 center or hospital as the result of being on ski patrol, or while
4 providing emergency aid or assistance without compensation at any
5 location, may not be held liable for civil damages for any alleged
6 act or omission which is claimed to have occurred during the
7 rendering of the emergency aid or assistance. The limitation of
8 liability established by the provisions of this section apply to
9 acts or omissions rendered in good faith.

10 (b) For the purposes of this section, a national ski patrol
11 system is a national organization whose members are volunteers and
12 do not receive compensation and are required to obtain training in
13 safety and emergency medical treatment.

14 (c) For purposes of this section, the term "compensation" does
15 not include access to a recreational facility, complimentary lift
16 tickets, food, lodging or other gifts or discounts that may be
17 offered or accessible to a person.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide immunity from liability for ski patrol rendering emergency care or assistance, without compensation, at any location.
