A BILL to amend and reenact §5F-2-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; and to amend said code by adding thereto twelve new sections, designated §5F-2-1a, §5F-2-1b, §5F-2-1c, §5F-2-1d, §5F-2-1e, §5F-2-1f, §5F-2-1g, §5F-2-1h, §5F-2-1i, §5F-2-1j, §5F-2-1k and §5F-2-11, all relating to the reorganization of certain code provisions that organize the executive branch of state government.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §5F-2-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted; and that said code be amended by adding

thereto twelve new sections, designated §5F-2-1a, §5F-2-1b, §5F-2-1c, §5F-2-1d, §5F-2-1e, §5F-2-1f, §5F-2-1g, §5F-2-1h, §5F-2-1i, §5F-2-1j, §5F-2-1k and §5F-2-1l, all to read as follows:

This section was enacted as part 214 of that legislation to effect the transfer of agencies and board and 215 related entities into the various departments created within the 216 executive branch of government. Since its initial enactment, the 217 Legislature has amended and reenacted this section on a number of occasions, in most instances to modify the initial 218

219	reorganization within the executive branch of government. The
220	Legislature further finds that the structure of this section by
221	which it provides an extensive list of executive agencies in a
222	single section of the code of West Virgina renders this section
223	unnecessarily lengthy and complicated. The designation of a
224	separate statute for each of the agencies and entities as they are
225	organized in subsections (a) through (l) of this subsection as
226	provided pursuant to the amendment and reenactment of this
227	section in 2011 would reduce the unnecessary length and
228	complexity of the statute without altering the Legislature's intent
229	in providing for the organization of the executive branch of state
230	government pursuant the original findings set forth under section
231	one, article one of this chapter and the Legislature's subsequent
232	amendments and reenactments of various sections of this
233	chapter. The Legislature therefore finds and declares that the
234	amendment and reenactment of this section and the further
235	amendment of the code of West Virginia by adding thereto
236	twelve new sections, designated §5F-2-1a, §5F-2-1b, §5F-2-1c,
237	§5F-2-1d, §5F-2-1e, §5F-2-1f, §5F-2-1g, §5F-2-1h, §5F-2-1i,
238	§5F-2-1i, §5F-2-1k and §5F-2-11 in 2013 are solely for purposes

239 of designating a separate statute for each of the agencies and 240 entities as they are organized in subsections (a) through (l) of 241 this subsection as provided pursuant to the amendment and 242 reenactment of this section in 2011, and in §5F-2-1k to provide 243 for corrective descriptions of an agency and to add an additional 244 agency to the list of agencies organized under that section. The 245 Legislature further finds and declares that except as otherwise 246 provided in this section, the amendment and reenactment of this 247 section and the enactment of the new sections as aforesaid in 248 2013 may not be construed to have altered or modified the 249 application of any other provision of this code to the agencies 250 and entities described in those sections, and that all other 251 provisions of this code, to the extent applicable to those 252 subsections, as well as the remaining subsections of this section, 253 shall to apply in like manner to the agencies and entities 254 described in those new sections. 255 (m)(b) Except for powers, authority and duties that have 256 been delegated to the secretaries of the departments by the 257 provisions of section two of this article, the position of 258 administrator and the powers, authority and duties of each administrator and agency are not affected by the enactment ofthis chapter.

261 (n)(c) Except for powers, authority and duties that have been 262 delegated to the secretaries of the departments by the provisions 263 of section two of this article, the existence, powers, authority and 264 duties of boards and the membership, terms and qualifications of 265 members of the boards are not affected by the enactment of this 266 chapter. All boards that are appellate bodies or are independent 267 decision makers shall not have their appellate or independent 268 decision-making status affected by the enactment of this chapter. 269 (o)(d) Any department previously transferred to and 270 incorporated in a department by prior enactment of this section 271 means a division of the appropriate department. Wherever 272 reference is made to any department transferred to and 273 incorporated in a department created in section two, article one 274 of this chapter, the reference means a division of the appropriate 275 department and any reference to a division of a department so 276 transferred and incorporated means a section of the appropriate 2.77 division of the department.

(p)(e) When an agency, board or commission is transferred under a bureau or agency other than a department headed by a
