## Senate Bill No. 118

(By Senators Jenkins, Fitzsimmons, McCabe and Williams)

[Introduced February 13, 2013; referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure; and then to the Committee on Finance.]

A BILL to amend and reenact §17A-3-14 of the Code of West

Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the

Division of Motor Vehicles to issue a special I Support

Veterans license plate; and establishing fees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §17A-3-14 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 3. ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION; ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.

§17A-3-14. Registration plates generally; description of plates; issuance of special numbers and plates; registration fees; special application fees; exemptions; commissioner to promulgate forms; suspension and nonrenewal.

(a) The division upon registering a vehicle shall issue to
 the owner one registration plate for a motorcycle, trailer,
 semitrailer or other motor vehicle.

4 (b) Registration plates issued by the division shall meet5 the following requirements:

6 (1) Every registration plate shall be of reflectorized 7 material and have displayed upon it the registration number 8 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued; the name of this 9 state, which may be abbreviated; and the year number for 10 which it is issued or the date of expiration of the plate.

(2) Every registration plate and the required letters and
 numerals on the plate shall be of sufficient size to be plainly
 readable from a distance of one hundred feet during daylight:
 *Provided*, That the requirements of this subdivision shall not

apply to the year number for which the plate is issued or thedate of expiration.

17 (3) Registration numbering for registration plates shall18 begin with number two.

19 (c) The division may not issue, permit to be issued or20 distribute any special registration plates except as follows:

(1) The Governor shall be issued two registration plates,on one of which shall be imprinted the numeral one and onthe other the word one.

24 (2) State officials and judges may be issued special25 registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to the Secretary of State, State Superintendent of Schools,
Auditor, Treasurer, Commissioner of Agriculture and the
Attorney General, the members of both houses of the
Legislature, including the elected officials of both houses of
the Legislature, the justices of the Supreme Court of Appeals
of West Virginia, the representatives and senators of the state

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in the Congress of the United States, the judges of the West 33 34 Virginia circuit courts, active and retired on senior status, the judges of the United States district courts for the State of 35 36 West Virginia and the judges of the United States Court of Appeals for the fourth circuit, if any of the judges are 37 residents of West Virginia, a special registration plate for a 38 Class A motor vehicle and a special registration plate for a 39 Class G motorcycle owned by the official or his or her 40 spouse: Provided, That the division may issue a Class A 41 special registration plate for each vehicle titled to the official 42 43 and a Class G special registration plate for each motorcycle 44 titled to the official.

(B) Each plate issued pursuant to this subdivision shall bear any combination of letters and numbers not to exceed an amount determined by the commissioner and a designation of the office. Each plate shall supersede the regular numbered plate assigned to the official or his or her spouse during the official's term of office and while the motor vehicle is owned by the official or his or her spouse. (C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for
every registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision,
which is in addition to all other fees required by this chapter.
(3) The division may issue members of the National
Guard forces special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon receipt of an application on a form prescribed 57 by the division and receipt of written evidence from the chief 58 executive officer of the Army National Guard or Air 59 National Guard, as appropriate, or the commanding officer 60 of any United States armed forces reserve unit that the 61 applicant is a member thereof, the division shall issue to any 62 63 member of the National Guard of this state or a member of any reserve unit of the United States armed forces a special 64 registration plate designed by the commissioner for any 65 number of Class A motor vehicles owned by the member. 66 67 Upon presentation of written evidence of retirement status, retired members of this state's Army or Air National Guard, 68 or retired members of any reserve unit of the United States 69

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armed forces, are eligible to purchase the special registrationplate issued pursuant to this subdivision.

(B) The division shall charge an initial application fee of
\$10 for each special registration plate issued pursuant to this
subdivision, which is in addition to all other fees required by
this chapter. Except as otherwise provided herein, effective
July 1, 2007, all fees currently held in the special revolving
fund used in the administration of this section and all fees
collected by the division shall be deposited in the State Road
Fund.

(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's National Guard forces license plate until
the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
license plate.

84 (4) Specially arranged registration plates may be issued85 as follows:

86 (A) Upon appropriate application, any owner of a motor87 vehicle subject to Class A registration, or a motorcycle

subject to Class G registration, as defined by this article, may request that the division issue a registration plate bearing specially arranged letters or numbers with the maximum number of letters or numbers to be determined by the commissioner. The division shall attempt to comply with the request wherever possible.

94 (B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative 95 approval in accordance with the provisions of chapter 96 twenty-nine-a of this code regarding the orderly distribution 97 of the plates: *Provided*, That for purposes of this 98 subdivision, the registration plates requested and issued shall 99 include all plates bearing the numbers two through two 100 thousand.

101 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each
102 special registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision,
103 which is in addition to all other fees required by this chapter.
104 (5) The division may issue honorably discharged veterans
105 special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the
armed services of the United States a special registration
plate for any number of vehicles titled in the name of the
qualified applicant with an insignia designed by the
Commissioner of the Division of Motor Vehicles.

112 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application 113 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This 114 special fee is to compensate the Division of Motor Vehicles for additional costs and services required in the issuing of the 115 special registration. All fees collected by the division shall 116 117 be deposited in the State Road Fund: Provided, That nothing in this section may be construed to exempt any veteran from 118 any other provision of this chapter. 119

(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's honorably discharged veterans license
plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not
renew the license plate.

124 (6) The division may issue disabled veterans special125 registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to any disabled veteran who is exempt from the payment of
registration fees under the provisions of this chapter a
registration plate for a vehicle titled in the name of the
qualified applicant which bears the letters "DV" in red and
also the regular identification numerals in red.

(B) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's disabled veterans license plate until the
surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
license plate.

(C) A qualified disabled veteran may obtain a second
disabled veterans license plate as described in this section for
use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified
applicant. The division shall charge a one-time fee of \$10 to
be deposited into the State Road Fund, in addition to all other
fees required by this chapter, for the second plate.

142 (7) The division may issue recipients of the distinguished143 Purple Heart medal special registration plates as follows:

144 (A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued to any armed service person holding the distinguished Purple 145 Heart medal for persons wounded in combat a registration 146 plate for a vehicle titled in the name of the qualified 147 applicant bearing letters or numbers. The registration plate 148 shall be designed by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles 149 150 and shall denote that those individuals who are granted this special registration plate are recipients of the Purple Heart. 151 All letterings shall be in purple where practical. 152

(B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision
are exempt from all registration fees otherwise required by
the provisions of this chapter.

(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's Purple Heart medal license plate until the
surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
license plate.

(D) A recipient of the Purple Heart medal may obtain a second Purple Heart medal license plate as described in this section for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge a one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the State Road Fund, in addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the second plate.

167 (8) The division may issue survivors of the attack on168 Pearl Harbor special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the owner of a motor
vehicle who was enlisted in any branch of the armed services
that participated in and survived the attack on Pearl Harbor
on December 7, 1941, the division shall issue a special
registration plate for a vehicle titled in the name of the
qualified applicant. The registration plate shall be designed
by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles.

(B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision
are exempt from the payment of all registration fees
otherwise required by the provisions of this chapter.

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(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased spouse's survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor license plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or

182 does not renew the license plate.

(D) A survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor may obtain
a second survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor license plate
as described in this section for use on a passenger vehicle
titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The division
shall charge a one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the
State Road Fund, in addition to all other fees required by this
chapter, for the second plate.

(9) The division may issue special registration plates to
nonprofit charitable and educational organizations authorized
under prior enactment of this subdivision as follows:

(A) Approved nonprofit charitable and educational
organizations previously authorized under the prior
enactment of this subdivision may accept and collect
applications for special registration plates from owners of

Class A motor vehicles together with a special annual fee of 197 \$15, which is in addition to all other fees required by this 198 199 chapter. The applications and fees shall be submitted to the Division of Motor Vehicles with the request that the division 200 issue a registration plate bearing a combination of letters or 201 202 numbers with the organizations' logo or emblem, with the maximum number of letters or numbers to be determined by 203 the commissioner. 204

(B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative
approval in accordance with the provisions of article three,
chapter twenty-nine-a of this code regarding the procedures
for and approval of special registration plates issued pursuant
to this subdivision.

(C) The commissioner shall set an appropriate fee to
defray the administrative costs associated with designing and
manufacturing special registration plates for a nonprofit
charitable or educational organization. The nonprofit
charitable or educational organization shall collect this fee

and forward it to the division for deposit in the State Road
Fund. The nonprofit charitable or educational organization
may also collect a fee for marketing the special registration
plates.

(10) The division may issue specified emergency orvolunteer registration plates as follows:

221 (A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the State of West Virginia and who is a certified paramedic 222 or emergency medical technician, a member of a paid fire 223 224 department, a member of the State Fire Commission, the State Fire Marshal, the State Fire Marshal's assistants, the 225 226 State Fire Administrator and voluntary rescue squad members may apply for a special license plate for any 227 number of Class A vehicles titled in the name of the qualified 228 applicant which bears the insignia of the profession, group or 229 230 commission. Any insignia shall be designed by the License plates issued pursuant to this 231 commissioner. subdivision shall bear the requested insignia in addition to 232

the registration number issued to the applicant pursuant tothe provisions of this article.

(B) Each application submitted pursuant to this
subdivision shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by
the fire chief or department head of the applicant stating that
the applicant is justified in having a registration with the
requested insignia; proof of compliance with all laws of this
state regarding registration and licensure of motor vehicles;
and payment of all required fees.

(C) Each application submitted pursuant to this
subdivision shall be accompanied by payment of a special
initial application fee of \$10, which is in addition to any
other registration or license fee required by this chapter. All
special fees shall be collected by the division and deposited
into the State Road Fund.

248 (11) The division may issue specified certified firefighter249 registration plates as follows:

(A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident ofthe State of West Virginia and who is a certified firefighter

may apply for a special license plate which bears the insignia 252 of the profession, for any number of Class A vehicles titled 253 254 in the name of the qualified applicant. Any insignia shall be designed by the commissioner. 255 License plates issued pursuant to this subdivision shall bear the requested insignia 256 257 pursuant to the provisions of this article. Upon presentation of written evidence of certification as a certified firefighter, 258 certified firefighters are eligible to purchase the special 259 260 registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision.

(B) Each application submitted pursuant to this 261 subdivision shall be accompanied by an affidavit stating that 262 263 the applicant is justified in having a registration with the requested insignia; proof of compliance with all laws of this 264 265 state regarding registration and licensure of motor vehicles; and payment of all required fees. The firefighter certification 266 267 department, section or division of the West Virginia 268 University fire service extension shall notify the commissioner in writing immediately when a firefighter 269

270 loses his or her certification. If a firefighter loses his or her271 certification, the commissioner may not issue him or her a272 license plate under this subsection.

(C) Each application submitted pursuant to this
subdivision shall be accompanied by payment of a special
initial application fee of \$10, which is in addition to any
other registration or license fee required by this chapter. All
special fees shall be collected by the division and deposited
into the State Road Fund.

(12) The division may issue special scenic registrationplates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the commissioner shall
issue a special registration plate displaying a scenic design of
West Virginia which displays the words "Wild Wonderful"
as a slogan.

(B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
this chapter. All initial application fees collected by the
division shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

(13) The division may issue honorably dischargedMarine Corps league members special registration plates asfollows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to any honorably discharged Marine Corps league member
a special registration plate for any number of vehicles titled
in the name of the qualified applicant with an insignia
designed by the Commissioner of the Division of Motor
Vehicles.

(B) The division may charge a special one-time initial
application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
this chapter. This special fee is to compensate the Division
of Motor Vehicles for additional costs and services required
in the issuing of the special registration and shall be collected
by the division and deposited in the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section may be construed to
exempt any veteran from any other provision of this chapter.

306 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
307 deceased spouse's honorably discharged Marine Corps
308 League license plate until the surviving spouse dies,
309 remarries or does not renew the license plate.

310 (14) The division may issue military organization311 registration plates as follows:

(A) The division may issue a special registration plate for 312 313 the members of any military organization chartered by the 314 United States Congress upon receipt of a guarantee from the 315 organization of a minimum of one hundred applicants. The insignia on the plate shall be designed by the commissioner. 316 317 (B) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue 318 members of the chartered organization in good standing, as 319 determined by the governing body of the chartered organization, a special registration plate for any number of 320 321 vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant.

322 (C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial323 application fee of \$10 for each special license plate in

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addition to all other fees required by this chapter. All initial application fees collected by the division shall be deposited into the State Road Fund: *Provided,* That nothing in this section may be construed to exempt any veteran from any

328 other provision of this chapter.

329 (D) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
330 deceased spouse's military organization registration plate
331 until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew
332 the special military organization registration plate.

333 (15) The division may issue special nongame wildlife
334 registration plates and special wildlife registration plates as
335 follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
a special registration plate displaying a species of West
Virginia wildlife which shall display a species of wildlife
native to West Virginia as prescribed and designated by the
commissioner and the Director of the Division of Natural
Resources.

342 (B) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for 343 each special nongame wildlife registration plate and each special wildlife registration plate in addition to all other fees 344 required by this chapter. All annual fees collected for 345 346 nongame wildlife registration plates and wildlife registration plates shall be deposited in a special revenue account 347 designated the Nongame Wildlife Fund and credited to the 348 Division of Natural Resources. 349

350 (C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
351 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
352 this chapter. All initial application fees collected by the
353 division shall be deposited in the State Road Fund.

354 (16) The division may issue members of the Silver355 Haired Legislature special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to any person who is a duly qualified member of the Silver
Haired Legislature a specialized registration plate which
bears recognition of the applicant as a member of the Silver
Haired Legislature.

(B) A qualified member of the Silver Haired Legislature
may obtain one registration plate described in this
subdivision for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name
of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge an
annual fee of \$15, in addition to all other fees required by
this chapter, for the plate. All annual fees collected by the
division shall be deposited in the State Road Fund.

(17) Upon appropriate application, the commissioner 368 shall issue to a classic motor vehicle or classic motorcycle as 369 370 defined in section three-a, article ten of this chapter, a special registration plate designed by the commissioner. An annual 371 372 fee of \$15, in addition to all other fees required by this chapter, shall be charged for each classic registration plate. 373 374 (18) Honorably discharged veterans may be issued 375 special registration plates for motorcycles subject to Class G 376 registration as follows:

377 (A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued378 to any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the

armed services of the United States a special registration
plate for any number of motorcycles subject to Class G
registration titled in the name of the qualified applicant with
an insignia designed by the Commissioner of the Division of
Motor Vehicles.

(B) A special initial application fee of \$10 shall be
charged in addition to all other fees required by law. This
special fee is to be collected by the division and deposited in
the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section
may be construed to exempt any veteran from any other
provision of this chapter.

390 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
391 deceased spouse's honorably discharged veterans license
392 plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not
393 renew the license plate.

394 (19) Racing theme special registration plates:

395 (A) The division may issue a series of special registration
396 plates displaying National Association for Stock Car Auto
397 Racing themes.

(B) An annual fee of \$25 shall be charged for each
special racing theme registration plate in addition to all other
fees required by this chapter. All annual fees collected for
each special racing theme registration plate shall be
deposited into the State Road Fund.

403 (C) A special application fee of \$10 shall be charged at
404 the time of initial application as well as upon application for
405 any duplicate or replacement registration plate, in addition to
406 all other fees required by this chapter. All application fees
407 shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

408 (20) The division may issue recipients of the Navy Cross,

409 Distinguished Service Cross, Distinguished Flying Cross, Air
410 Force Cross, Bronze Star, Silver Star or Air Medal special
411 registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to any recipient of the Navy Cross, Distinguished Service
Cross, Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver
Star, Bronze Star or Air Medal, a registration plate for any

number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified 416 applicant bearing letters or numbers. A separate registration 417 plate shall be designed by the Commissioner of Motor 418 419 Vehicles for each award that denotes that those individuals who are granted this special registration plate are recipients 420 421 of the Navy Cross, Distinguished Service Cross, Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver Star or 422 423 Bronze Star, or Air Medal as applicable.

424 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
425 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
426 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in
427 the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section
428 exempts the applicant for a special registration plate under
429 this subdivision from any other provision of this chapter.

430 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
431 deceased spouse's Navy Cross, Distinguished Service Cross,
432 Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver Star,
433 Bronze Star or Air Medal special registration plate until the

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434 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the435 special registration plate.

436 (21) The division may issue honorably discharged437 veterans special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue 438 to any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the 439 armed services of the United States with verifiable service 440 during World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, the 441 Persian Gulf War or the War Against Terrorism a special 442 443 registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant with an insignia designed by 444 445 the commissioner denoting service in the applicable conflict. 446 (B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 447 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by 448 law. This special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the State Road Fund: Provided, That nothing 449 contained in this section may be construed to exempt any 450 451 veteran from any other provision of this chapter.

452 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
453 deceased spouse's honorably discharged veterans registration
454 plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not
455 renew the special registration plate.

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456 (22) The division may issue special volunteer firefighter457 registration plates as follows:

(A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of 458 West Virginia and who is a volunteer firefighter may apply 459 for a special license plate for any Class A vehicle titled in the 460 name of the qualified applicant which bears the insignia of 461 the profession in white letters on a red background. The 462 463 insignia shall be designed by the commissioner and shall contain a fireman's helmet insignia on the left side of the 464 465 license plate.

466 (B) Each application submitted pursuant to this
467 subdivision shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by
468 the applicant's fire chief, stating that the applicant is a
469 volunteer firefighter and justified in having a registration

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plate with the requested insignia. The applicant must complywith all other laws of this state regarding registration andlicensure of motor vehicles and must pay all required fees.

473 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this
474 subdivision shall be accompanied by payment of a special
475 one-time initial application fee of \$10, which is in addition
476 to any other registration or license fee required by this
477 chapter. All application fees shall be deposited into the State
478 Road Fund.

479 (23) The division may issue special registration plates
480 which reflect patriotic themes, including the display of any
481 United States symbol, icon, phrase or expression which
482 evokes patriotic pride or recognition.

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to an applicant a registration plate of the applicant's choice,
displaying a patriotic theme as provided in this subdivision,
for a vehicle titled in the name of the applicant. A series of
registration plates displaying patriotic themes shall be

488 designed by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles for489 distribution to applicants.

(B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
law. This special fee shall be collected by the division and
deposited in the State Road Fund.

494 (24) Special license plates bearing the American flag and495 the logo "9/11/01".

496 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
497 special registration plates which shall display the American
498 flag and the logo "9/11/01".

(B) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each platein addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

501 (C) A special application fee of \$10 shall be charged at 502 the time of initial application as well as upon application for 503 any duplicate or replacement registration plate, in addition to 504 all other fees required by this chapter. All application fees 505 shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

506 (25) The division may issue a special registration plate 507 celebrating the centennial of the 4-H youth development 508 movement and honoring the Future Farmers of America 509 organization as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue
a special registration plate depicting the symbol of the 4-H
organization which represents the head, heart, hands and
health as well as the symbol of the Future Farmers of
America organization which represents a cross section of an
ear of corn for any number of vehicles titled in the name of
the qualified applicant.

(B) The division shall charge a special initial application
fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in
the State Road Fund.

(C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for
each special 4-H Future Farmers of America registration
plate in addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

(26) The division may issue special registration plates to
educators in the state's elementary and secondary schools
and in the state's institutions of higher education as follows:
(A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue
a special registration plate designed by the commissioner for
any number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified
applicant.

(B) The division shall charge a special initial application
fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in
the State Road Fund.

(C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for
each special educator registration plate in addition to all
other fees required by this chapter.

538 (27) The division may issue special registration plates to539 members of the Nemesis Shrine as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issuea special registration plate designed by the commissioner for

any number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified
applicant. Persons desiring the special registration plate
shall offer sufficient proof of membership in Nemesis Shrine.
(B) The division shall charge a special initial application
fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in
the State Road Fund.

549 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate550 in addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

551 (D) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (d) of 552 this section, the time period for the Nemesis Shrine to 553 comply with the minimum one hundred prepaid applications 554 is hereby extended to January 15, 2005.

(28) The division may issue volunteers and employees of
the American Red Cross special registration plates as
follows:

- 1155 Assistance for any number of vehicles titled in the name of
- 1156 the qualified applicant.
- 1157 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
- 1158 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
- 1159 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in
- 1160 the State Road Fund.
- 1161 (C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for
- 1162 each special registration plate in addition to all other fees
- 1163 required by this chapter.
- 1164 (d) The minimum number of applications required prior
- 1165 to design and production of a special license plate shall be as
- 1166 follows:

(1) The commissioner may not begin the design or 1167 production of any license plates for which eligibility is based 1168 on membership or affiliation with a particular private 1169 1170 organization until at least one hundred persons complete an application and deposit with the organization a check to 1171 cover the first year's basic registration, one-time design and 1172 manufacturing costs and to cover the first year additional 1173 annual fee. If the organization fails to submit the required 1174 number of applications with attached checks within six 1175 months of the effective date of the original authorizing 1176 1177 legislation, the plate will not be produced and will require 1178 legislative reauthorization: *Provided*. That an organization 1179 or group that is unsuccessful in obtaining the minimum 1180 number of applications may not request reconsideration of a 1181 special plate until at least two years have passed since the effective date of the original authorization: 1182 Provided. however, That the provisions of this subdivision (1) are not 1183 applicable to the issuance of plates authorized pursuant to 1184 subdivision (60), subsection (c) of this section. 1185

(2) The commissioner may not begin the design or 1186 production of any license plates authorized by this section for 1187 which membership or affiliation with a particular 1188 organization is not required until at least two hundred fifty 1189 registrants complete an application and deposit a fee with the 1190 division to cover the first year's basic registration fee, one-1191 1192 time design and manufacturing fee and additional annual fee if applicable. If the commissioner fails to receive the 1193 required number of applications within six months of the 1194 effective date of the original authorizing legislation, the plate 1195 1196 will not be produced and will require legislative reauthorization: *Provided*. That if the minimum number of 1197 applications is not satisfied within the six months of the 1198 1199 effective date of the original authorizing legislation, a person may not request reconsideration of a special plate until at 1200 least two years have passed since the effective date of the 1201 original authorization. 1202

(e) (1) Nothing in this section requires a charge for a free
prisoner of war license plate or a free recipient of the
Congressional Medal of Honor license plate for a vehicle
titled in the name of the qualified applicant as authorized by
other provisions of this code.

(2) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's prisoner of war license plate or
Congressional Medal of Honor license plate until the
surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
license plate.

(3) Qualified former prisoners of war and recipients of
the Congressional Medal of Honor may obtain a second
special registration plate for use on a passenger vehicle titled
in the name of the qualified applicant. The division shall
charge a one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the State
Road Fund, in addition to all other fees required by this
chapter, for the second special plate.

(f) The division may issue special ten-year registrationplates as follows:

(1) The commissioner may issue or renew for a period of 1222 no more than ten years any registration plate exempted from 1223 registration fees pursuant to any provision of this code or any 1224 restricted use antique motor vehicle license plate authorized 1225 by section three-a, article ten of this chapter: Provided, That 1226 the provisions of this subsection do not apply to any person 1227 who has had a special registration suspended for failure to 1228 maintain motor vehicle liability insurance as required by 1229 1230 section three, article two-a, chapter seventeen-d of this code 1231 or failure to pay personal property taxes as required by 1232 section three-a of this article.

(2) An initial nonrefundable fee shall be charged for each
special registration plate issued pursuant to this subsection,
which is the total amount of fees required by section fifteen,
article ten of this chapter, section three, article three of this
chapter or section three-a, article ten of this chapter for the
period requested.

(g) The provisions of this section may not be construed
to exempt any registrant from maintaining motor vehicle
liability insurance as required by section three, article two-a,
chapter seventeen-d of this code or from paying personal
property taxes on any motor vehicle as required by section
three-a of this article.

(h) The commissioner may, in his or her discretion, issue 1245 a registration plate of reflectorized material suitable for 1246 permanent use on motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers, 1247 together with appropriate devices to be attached to the 1248 registration to indicate the year for which the vehicles have 1249 1250 been properly registered or the date of expiration of the registration. The design and expiration of the plates shall be 1251 1252 determined by the commissioner. The commissioner shall, whenever possible and cost effective, implement the latest 1253 1254 technology in the design, production and issuance of 1255 registration plates, indices of registration renewal and vehicle 1256 ownership documents, including, but not limited to, offering

1257	Internet renewal of vehicle registration and the use of bar
1258	codes for instant identification of vehicles by scanning
1259	equipment to promote the efficient and effective coordination
1260	and communication of data for improving highway safety,
1261	aiding law enforcement and enhancing revenue collection.
1262	(i) Any license plate issued or renewed pursuant to this
1263	chapter which is paid for by a check that is returned for
1264	nonsufficient funds is void without further notice to the
1265	applicant. The applicant may not reinstate the registration
	applicant. The applicant may not reinstate the registration until the returned check is paid by the applicant in cash,
