Senate Bill No. 448

(By Senators Beach, Plymale, Fitzsimmons and Williams)

[Originating in the Committee on Finance; reported March 26, 2013.]

A BILL to amend and reenact §17A-6-10c of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the commissioner to issue no more than ten additional special demonstration plates, upon a showing of need, to new and used motor vehicle dealers engaged in the business of selling trailers, truck-tractors, road-tractors or trucks and that demonstrate the motor vehicles under actual work conditions to potential purchasers; and setting fee amount for additional plates.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §17A-6-10c of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 6. LICENSING OF DEALERS AND WRECKERS OR DISMANTLERS; SPECIAL PLATES; TEMPORARY PLATES OR MARKERS.

PART III. FEES AND DEALER SPECIAL PLATES GENERALLY.

§17A-6-10c. Special demonstration plates for dealers in trailers, truck-tractors, road-tractors and trucks; application; fee.

- 1 (a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this code,
- 2 any a new motor vehicle dealer or used motor vehicle dealer
- 3 engaged in the business of selling trailers, truck-tractors,
- 4 road-tractors or trucks who demonstrates that demonstrates
- 5 the motor vehicles under actual work conditions to potential
- 6 purchasers shall obtain a special demonstration plate from
- 7 the Division of Motor Vehicles. The motor vehicle dealer
- 8 may obtain special demonstration plates without first titling
- 9 or registering each vehicle.

10 (b) The commissioner shall prescribe the application 11 form for these special demonstration plates and shall require 12 the applicant to submit proof of the applicant's status as a 13 bona fide dealer in motor vehicles and to certify that the 14 applicant needs special demonstration plates in the ordinary

course of business.

The commissioner, upon approving any an application, 16 shall issue to the new motor vehicle dealer or used motor 17 vehicle dealer up to four special demonstration plates which 18 shall display the term "demonstration" or "demo" and a 19 distinguishing number assigned to the motor vehicle dealer. 20 21 The commissioner may issue no more than ten additional special demonstration plates to a licensee upon a showing 22 that the licensee has sales or potential sales justifying 23 additional plates. This showing may include, but is not 24 25 limited to, the dealer's on-site inventory of the applicable type of vehicles, previous sales of applicable vehicles or the 26 geographical divergence of the dealer's customer base. 27

- 28 (c) The annual fee for special demonstration plates is
- 29 \$100 for the first plate and \$50 for each additional special
- 30 <u>demonstration</u> plate <u>that is issued</u>, not to exceed a total of
- 31 four fourteen plates per dealer.
- 32 (d) Each motor vehicle dealer who is issued special
- 33 demonstration plates shall keep a written record, on a form
- 34 approved by the commissioner and open to inspection by a
- 35 police officer or employee of the division, containing the
- 36 following information:
- 37 (1) Identification of the motor vehicles upon which the
- 38 special demonstration plates are used;
- 39 (2) The times and dates during which each special
- 40 demonstration plate is used;
- 41 (3) The name and address of the company or individual
- 42 using a motor vehicle on which a special demonstration plate
- 43 is used; and
- 44 (4) any Other information considered necessary by the
- 45 commissioner. This record shall be open to inspection by
- 46 any police officer or employee of the division.

- 47 (e) Each motor vehicle operated under the provisions of
- 48 this section is considered to be registered at the maximum
- 49 vehicle weights allowable under article seventeen, chapter
- 50 seventeen-c of this code.
- 51 (f) A motor vehicle dealer shall not:
- 52 (1) Use any a special demonstration plates plate issued
- 53 under the provisions of this section on any a motor vehicle
- 54 which is not being demonstrated;
- 55 (2) Use any a special demonstration plates plate to
- 56 demonstrate any a single motor vehicle for more than seven
- 57 calendar days in any a calendar year for any a single
- 58 customer;
- 59 (3) Use any a special demonstration plates on any plate
- 60 on a motor vehicle leased or rented to any a customer; or
- 61 (4) Use any a special demonstration plates plate in any
- way other than to demonstrate the on-the-job capabilities of
- 63 a motor vehicle to a potential purchaser.

(g) The motor vehicle dealer is required to furnish a certificate of insurance in the amount required by regulations of the West Virginia Public Service Commission or the United States Department of Transportation for the class of motor carrier for which the motor vehicle is to be demonstrated.
