A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §4-2-4a; and to amend said code by adding thereto a new section, designated §30-1A-2a, all relating to the Legislative Auditor; authorizing the Legislative Auditor to establish and charge fees for the sunrise application review process; reporting requirements; and terminating these fees on July 1, 2015.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto two new sections designated §4-2-4a and §30-1A-2a, all to read as follows:

CHAPTER 4. THE LEGISLATURE.

ARTICLE 2. LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR; POWERS; FUNCTIONS; DUTIES; COMPENSATION.

§4-2-4a. Authorizing Auditor to establish and charge fees for the sunrise application review process.

- 1 (a) The Legislative Auditor may establish a graduated fee
- 2 schedule related to the actual cost for the review of a sunrise
- 3 application, under the provisions of article one-a, chapter
- 4 thirty of this code.
- 5 (b) The Legislative Auditor may collect, and the
- 6 professional or occupational group or organization, an
- 7 individual or board shall pay, the fee established by the
- 8 Legislative Auditor for the review of a sunrise application.
- 9 (c) The Legislative Auditor shall render to the
- 10 professional or occupational group or organization,
- individual or board liable for the fee a statement of the fee as
- soon as practicable after the costs were incurred. It is the
- 13 duty of the professional or occupational group or

- 14 organization, an individual or board to promptly pay in the
- 15 manner that other claims and accounts are paid.
- 16 (d) The money received by the Legislative Auditor from
- 17 this source shall be expended only for the purpose of
- 18 covering the costs associated with the review of a sunrise
- 19 application, unless otherwise directed by the Legislature.
- 20 (e) The Legislative Auditor shall report annually by
- 21 January 1 to the Joint Committee on Government
- 22 Organization the following:
- 23 (1) The fees charged for the review of sunrise
- 24 applications;
- 25 (2) The professional or occupational group or
- organization, individual or board liable for the fee;
- 27 (3) Whether the fees were paid promptly; and
- 28 (4) Any other information required by the Joint
- 29 Committee on Government Organization.
- 30 (f) The provisions of this section terminate on July 1,
- 31 2015.

CHAPTER 30. PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS.

ARTICLE 1A. PROCEDURE FOR REGULATION OF OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS.

§30-1A-2a. Fee schedule for sunrise application review process.

- 1 (a) The Legislative Auditor may collect, and the
- 2 professional or occupational group or organization, an
- 3 individual or board shall pay, the fee established by the
- 4 Legislative Auditor for the review of a sunrise application,
- 5 established under the provisions of section four-a, article two,
- 6 chapter four of this code.
- 7 (b) The provisions of this section terminate on July 1,
- 8 2015.
