A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §16-2J-3a, relating to authorizing continued operation of certain preventative care programs after expiration date of the pilot program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §16-2J-3a, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2J. PREVENTIVE CARE PILOT PROGRAM.

§16-2J-3a. Preventive care programs established by the preventive care pilot program.

- 1 Notwithstanding the expiration of the preventive care
- 2 pilot program, any preventive care program licensed prior to
- 3 June 30, 2011, by the commissioner pursuant to section four
- 4 of this article may continue to market and sell prepaid
- 5 memberships entitling subscribers to obtain preventative and
- 6 primary health care from the participating provider:
- 7 Provided: That any preventive care program and any
- 8 participating provider operating a preventive care program
- 9 are subject to all requirements and conditions set forth in this
- 10 article.
