A BILL to amend and reenact §30-4-13 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; and to amend said code by adding thereto a new section, designated §30-4-13a, all relating to the practice of dentistry; and updating the requirements for dental intern, dental resident and dental teaching permits.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §30-4-13 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted; and that said code be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §30-4-13a, all to read as follows:

ARTICLE 4. WEST VIRGINIA DENTAL PRACTICE ACT. §30-4-13. Dental intern or dental resident permit.

1 (a) The board may issue a dental intern or dental resident permit to an applicant who:

- 1 (1) Has been accepted as a dental intern or dental
- 2 resident by a licensed hospital or dental school with an
- 3 established dental department;
- 4 (2) Is under the supervision of a licensed dentist;
- 5 (3) Has graduated with a degree in dentistry from an
- 6 accredited dental college, school or dental department of a
- 7 university;
- 8 (4) Has paid the applicable fees; and
- 9 (5) Meets any other requirements specified by the
- 10 board.
- 11 (b) The dental intern or dental resident permit may be
- renewed and expires on the earlier of:
- 13 (1) The date the permit holder ceases to be a dental
- 14 intern or dental resident; or
- 15 (2) One year after the date of issue.
- 16 (c) While the dental intern or dental resident permit is
- in effect, a permittee is:
- 18 (1) Subject to the restrictions and requirements imposed
- 19 by this article; and

(2) Not allowed to receive any fee for service, other

than a salary paid by the hospital or dental school. 21

§30-4-13a. Dental teaching permit.

- 1 (a) The board may issue a dental teaching permit to
- 2 an applicant who is not licensed to practice dentistry in this
- 3 state and who meets the following conditions:
- 4 (1) Shall have an authorization to practice dentistry in
- 5 another jurisdiction or has been eligible for an authorization
- 6 to practice dentistry in another jurisdiction; and
- (2) Has met, or been approved under, the credentialing 7
- standards of a dental school or an academic medical center 8
- with which the person is to be affiliated: *Provided*, That the 9
- dental school or academic medical center shall be accredited 10
- 11 by the Commission on Dental Accreditation or the Joint
- Commission on Accreditation of Health Care Organizations; 12
- 13 (b) A dental teaching permit is valid for one year and may be
- renewed. To renew a dental teaching permit, the applicant 14
- shall: 15

- 16 (1) Submit to the board a written recommendation from
- 17 the dental school dean;
- 18 (2) Successfully complete the West Virginia Dental
- 19 Law Examination;
- 20 (3) Pay the applicable renewal fees;
- 21 (4) Complete the applicable continuing education
- 22 requirements; and
- 23 (5) Have no disciplinary actions taken or pending
- against him or her by any jurisdiction.
- 25 (c) A person who has been issued a dental teaching
- 26 permit may:
- 27 (1) Teach at a dental school or college offering a
- doctoral degree in dentistry in this state, at a teaching hospital
- 29 adjacent to a dental school or at an academic medical center;
- 30 and
- 31 (2) Practice dentistry at a dental school or college
- 32 offering a doctoral degree in dentistry in this state, at
- 33 a teaching hospital adjacent to a dental school or at an
- 34 academic medical center.

- 35 (d) While the dental teaching permit is in effect, a 36 permittee is:
- 37 (1) Subject to the restrictions and requirements imposed38 by this article; and
- (2) Not allowed to receive any fee for service, other
 than a salary paid by the dental school or academic medical
 center.
