A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §29-22A-20, relating to establishing a gaming industry special study committee to assess problems facing the gaming industry in West Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §29-22A-20, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 22A. RACETRACK VIDEO LOTTERY.

§29-22A-20. Establishment of gaming industry special study committee.

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- 1 (a) The gaming industry in West Virginia has been
- 2 subject to increasing competitive pressure as the neighboring
- 3 states of Ohio, Pennsylvania and Maryland have sought to
- 4 increase tax revenues by expanding gaming activities in their
- 5 states. For years West Virginia benefitted from gaming
- 6 facilities in our eastern and northern panhandles which drew
- 7 residents from border states that had few gambling options.
- 8 But with growing casino operations in Ohio, Pennsylvania
- 9 and Maryland, that advantage has markedly declined,
- 10 threatening our gaming industry and the state tax revenues
- 11 which are realized from our gaming industry.
- 12 (b) There is created a gaming industry special study
- 13 committee to assess the issues facing the gaming industry and
- 14 to offer recommendations to address the problems identified
- 15 by the committee. The gaming industry special study
- 16 committee is comprised of the following members:
- 17 (1) Three members of the Senate appointed by the
- 18 President of the Senate;

- 19 (2) Three members of the House of Delegates appointed
- 20 by the Speaker of the House of Delegates;
- 21 (3) Two members from the office of the Racing
- 22 Commission appointed by the Governor;
- 23 (4) Two members from the office of the Lottery
- 24 Commission appointed by the Governor; and
- 25 (5) One member from the Governor's Office appointed by
- 26 the Governor.
- 27 (c) The gaming industry special study committee shall
- 28 report to the Legislature its findings, conclusions,
- 29 recommendations and proposed legislation on January 1,
- 30 2015.

(NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create a gaming industry special study committee to assess problems facing the gaming industry in West Virginia and to make recommendations to the Legislature on January 1, 2015.
