

# H. B. 2541

**[BY REQUEST OF THE EXECUTIVE]**

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[Introduced February 19, 2013; referred to the  
Committee on Finance.]

A BILL making a supplementary appropriation from the State Fund, State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund, to the Department of Health and Human Resources, Division of Human Services, fund 5365, fiscal year 2013, organization 0511, by supplementing and amending the appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 20, 2013.

WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature the Executive Budget document, dated February 13, 2013, containing a Statement of the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund, setting forth therein the unappropriated balance as of July 1, 2012, and further included the estimate of revenue for the fiscal year 2013, less net regular appropriations for the fiscal year 2013; and

WHEREAS, It appears from the Governor’s Statement of the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund there now remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013; therefore

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, to fund 5365, fiscal year 2013, organization 0511, be supplemented and amended by increasing an existing item of appropriation as follows:
