Senate Bill No. 118

(By Senators Jenkins, Fitzsimmons, McCabe and Williams)

[Introduced February 13, 2013; referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure; and then to the Committee on Finance.]

A BILL to amend and reenact §17A-3-14 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Division of Motor Vehicles to issue special license plates; authorizing issuance of a special I Support Veterans license plate; authorizing issuance of a special next-of-kin of a lawenforcement officer killed in the line of duty license plate; and establishing fees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §17A-3-14 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION; ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.

§17A-3-14. Registration plates generally; description of plates; issuance of special numbers and plates; registration fees; special application fees; exemptions; commissioner to promulgate forms; suspension and nonrenewal.

(a) The division upon registering a vehicle shall issue to
 the owner one registration plate for a motorcycle, trailer,
 semitrailer or other motor vehicle.

4 (b) Registration plates issued by the division shall meet5 the following requirements:

6 (1) Every registration plate shall be of reflectorized 7 material and have displayed upon it the registration number 8 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued; the name of this 9 state, which may be abbreviated; and the year number for 10 which it is issued or the date of expiration of the plate.

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11	(2) Every registration plate and the required letters and
12	numerals on the plate shall be of sufficient size to be plainly
13	readable from a distance of one hundred feet during daylight:
14	Provided, That the requirements of this subdivision shall not
15	apply to the year number for which the plate is issued or the
16	date of expiration.
17	(3) Registration numbering for registration plates shall
18	begin with number two.
19	(c) The division may not issue, permit to be issued or
20	distribute any special registration plates except as follows:
21	(1) The Governor shall be issued two registration plates,
22	on one of which shall be imprinted the numeral one and on
23	the other the word one.
24	(2) State officials and judges may be issued special
25	registration plates as follows:
26	(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue

to the Secretary of State, State Superintendent of Schools,
Auditor, Treasurer, Commissioner of Agriculture and the
Attorney General, the members of both houses of the

Legislature, including the elected officials of both houses of 30 31 the Legislature, the justices of the Supreme Court of Appeals 32 of West Virginia, the representatives and senators of the state 33 in the Congress of the United States, the judges of the West 34 Virginia circuit courts, active and retired on senior status, the 35 judges of the United States district courts for the State of 36 West Virginia and the judges of the United States Court of 37 Appeals for the fourth circuit, if any of the judges are residents of West Virginia, a special registration plate for a 38 Class A motor vehicle and a special registration plate for a 39 Class G motorcycle owned by the official or his or her 40 spouse: *Provided*. That the division may issue a Class A 41 special registration plate for each vehicle titled to the official 42 and a Class G special registration plate for each motorcycle 43 44 titled to the official.

(B) Each plate issued pursuant to this subdivision shall
bear any combination of letters and numbers not to exceed an
amount determined by the commissioner and a designation of
the office. Each plate shall supersede the regular numbered

49 plate assigned to the official or his or her spouse during the
50 official's term of office and while the motor vehicle is owned
51 by the official or his or her spouse.

(C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for
every registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision,
which is in addition to all other fees required by this chapter.
(3) The division may issue members of the National
Guard forces special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon receipt of an application on a form prescribed 57 58 by the division and receipt of written evidence from the chief executive officer of the Army National Guard or Air National 59 Guard, as appropriate, or the commanding officer of any 60 61 United States armed forces reserve unit that the applicant is 62 a member thereof, the division shall issue to any member of 63 the National Guard of this state or a member of any reserve 64 unit of the United States armed forces a special registration 65 plate designed by the commissioner for any number of Class A motor vehicles owned by the member. Upon presentation 66 67 of written evidence of retirement status, retired members of

this state's Army or Air National Guard, or retired members
of any reserve unit of the United States armed forces, are
eligible to purchase the special registration plate issued
pursuant to this subdivision.

72 (B) The division shall charge an initial application fee of \$10 for each special registration plate issued pursuant to this 73 74 subdivision, which is in addition to all other fees required by 75 this chapter. Except as otherwise provided herein, effective July 1, 2007, all fees currently held in the special revolving 76 77 fund used in the administration of this section and all fees 78 collected by the division shall be deposited in the State Road Fund. 79

(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's National Guard forces license plate until
the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
license plate.

84 (4) Specially arranged registration plates may be issued85 as follows:

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(A) Upon appropriate application, any owner of a motor 86 87 vehicle subject to Class A registration, or a motorcycle 88 subject to Class G registration, as defined by this article, may 89 request that the division issue a registration plate bearing specially arranged letters or numbers with the maximum 90 91 number of letters or numbers to be determined by the 92 commissioner. The division shall attempt to comply with the request wherever possible. 93

94 (B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative
95 approval in accordance with the provisions of chapter
96 twenty-nine-a of this code regarding the orderly distribution
97 of the plates: *Provided*, That for purposes of this
98 subdivision, the registration plates requested and issued shall
99 include all plates bearing the numbers two through two
100 thousand.

101 (C) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each
102 special registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision,
103 which is in addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

104 (5) The division may issue honorably discharged veterans105 special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the
armed services of the United States a special registration
plate for any number of vehicles titled in the name of the
qualified applicant with an insignia designed by the
Commissioner of the Division of Motor Vehicles.

112 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application 113 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This 114 special fee is to compensate the Division of Motor Vehicles for additional costs and services required in the issuing of the 115 116 special registration. All fees collected by the division shall 117 be deposited in the State Road Fund: Provided, That nothing 118 in this section may be construed to exempt any veteran from 119 any other provision of this chapter.

(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or herdeceased spouse's honorably discharged veterans license

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plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does notrenew the license plate.

124 (6) The division may issue disabled veterans special125 registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to any disabled veteran who is exempt from the payment of
registration fees under the provisions of this chapter a
registration plate for a vehicle titled in the name of the
qualified applicant which bears the letters "DV" in red and
also the regular identification numerals in red.

(B) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's disabled veterans license plate until the
surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
license plate.

(C) A qualified disabled veteran may obtain a second
disabled veterans license plate as described in this section for
use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified
applicant. The division shall charge a one-time fee of \$10 to

be deposited into the State Road Fund, in addition to all otherfees required by this chapter, for the second plate.

142 (7) The division may issue recipients of the distinguished143 Purple Heart medal special registration plates as follows:

144 (A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued to 145 any armed service person holding the distinguished Purple 146 Heart medal for persons wounded in combat a registration plate for a vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant 147 bearing letters or numbers. The registration plate shall be 148 149 designed by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and shall 150 denote that those individuals who are granted this special registration plate are recipients of the Purple Heart. All 151 152 letterings shall be in purple where practical.

(B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision
are exempt from all registration fees otherwise required by
the provisions of this chapter.

(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or herdeceased spouse's Purple Heart medal license plate until the

158 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the159 license plate.

(D) A recipient of the Purple Heart medal may obtain a
second Purple Heart medal license plate as described in this
section for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of
the qualified applicant. The division shall charge a one-time
fee of \$10 to be deposited into the State Road Fund, in
addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the
second plate.

167 (8) The division may issue survivors of the attack on168 Pearl Harbor special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the owner of a motor
vehicle who was enlisted in any branch of the armed services
that participated in and survived the attack on Pearl Harbor
on December 7, 1941, the division shall issue a special
registration plate for a vehicle titled in the name of the
qualified applicant. The registration plate shall be designed
by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles.

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(B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision
are exempt from the payment of all registration fees
otherwise required by the provisions of this chapter.

(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor
license plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or
does not renew the license plate.

(D) A survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor may obtain
a second survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor license plate
as described in this section for use on a passenger vehicle
titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The division
shall charge a one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the
State Road Fund, in addition to all other fees required by this
chapter, for the second plate.

(9) The division may issue special registration plates to
nonprofit charitable and educational organizations authorized
under prior enactment of this subdivision as follows:

(A) Approved nonprofit charitable and educationalorganizations previously authorized under the prior

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195 enactment of this subdivision may accept and collect 196 applications for special registration plates from owners of Class A motor vehicles together with a special annual fee of 197 198 \$15, which is in addition to all other fees required by this 199 chapter. The applications and fees shall be submitted to the 200 Division of Motor Vehicles with the request that the division issue a registration plate bearing a combination of letters or 201 202 numbers with the organizations' logo or emblem, with the 203 maximum number of letters or numbers to be determined by the commissioner. 204

(B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative
approval in accordance with the provisions of article three,
chapter twenty-nine-a of this code regarding the procedures
for and approval of special registration plates issued pursuant
to this subdivision.

(C) The commissioner shall set an appropriate fee to
defray the administrative costs associated with designing and
manufacturing special registration plates for a nonprofit
charitable or educational organization. The nonprofit

charitable or educational organization shall collect this fee
and forward it to the division for deposit in the State Road
Fund. The nonprofit charitable or educational organization
may also collect a fee for marketing the special registration
plates.

(10) The division may issue specified emergency orvolunteer registration plates as follows:

221 (A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the State of West Virginia and who is a certified paramedic or 222 emergency medical technician, a member of a paid fire 223 224 department, a member of the State Fire Commission, the 225 State Fire Marshal, the State Fire Marshal's assistants, the 226 State Fire Administrator and voluntary rescue squad 227 members may apply for a special license plate for any 228 number of Class A vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant which bears the insignia of the profession, group or 229 Any insignia shall be designed by the 230 commission. commissioner. License plates issued pursuant to this 231 232 subdivision shall bear the requested insignia in addition to

the registration number issued to the applicant pursuant to theprovisions of this article.

(B) Each application submitted pursuant to this
subdivision shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by
the fire chief or department head of the applicant stating that
the applicant is justified in having a registration with the
requested insignia; proof of compliance with all laws of this
state regarding registration and licensure of motor vehicles;
and payment of all required fees.

(C) Each application submitted pursuant to this
subdivision shall be accompanied by payment of a special
initial application fee of \$10, which is in addition to any
other registration or license fee required by this chapter. All
special fees shall be collected by the division and deposited
into the State Road Fund.

248 (11) The division may issue specified certified firefighter249 registration plates as follows:

(A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of theState of West Virginia and who is a certified firefighter may

apply for a special license plate which bears the insignia of 252 the profession, for any number of Class A vehicles titled in 253 254 the name of the qualified applicant. Any insignia shall be designed by the commissioner. License plates issued 255 256 pursuant to this subdivision shall bear the requested insignia 257 pursuant to the provisions of this article. Upon presentation 258 of written evidence of certification as a certified firefighter, certified firefighters are eligible to purchase the special 259 260 registration plate issued pursuant to this subdivision.

(B) Each application submitted pursuant to this 261 262 subdivision shall be accompanied by an affidavit stating that the applicant is justified in having a registration with the 263 264 requested insignia: proof of compliance with all laws of this 265 state regarding registration and licensure of motor vehicles; 266 and payment of all required fees. The firefighter certification department, section or division of the West Virginia 267 University service extension 268 fire shall notify the 269 commissioner in writing immediately when a firefighter loses 270 his or her certification. If a firefighter loses his or her

271 certification, the commissioner may not issue him or her a272 license plate under this subsection.

(C) Each application submitted pursuant to this
subdivision shall be accompanied by payment of a special
initial application fee of \$10, which is in addition to any
other registration or license fee required by this chapter. All
special fees shall be collected by the division and deposited
into the State Road Fund.

(12) The division may issue special scenic registrationplates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the commissioner shall
issue a special registration plate displaying a scenic design of
West Virginia which displays the words "Wild Wonderful"
as a slogan.

(B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
this chapter. All initial application fees collected by the
division shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

289	(13) The division may issue honorably discharged Marine
290	Corps league members special registration plates as follows:
291	(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
292	to any honorably discharged Marine Corps league member a
293	special registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in
294	the name of the qualified applicant with an insignia designed
295	by the Commissioner of the Division of Motor Vehicles.
296	(B) The division may charge a special one-time initial
297	application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
298	this chapter. This special fee is to compensate the Division
299	of Motor Vehicles for additional costs and services required
300	in the issuing of the special registration and shall be collected
301	by the division and deposited in the State Road Fund:
302	Provided, That nothing in this section may be construed to
303	exempt any veteran from any other provision of this chapter.
304	(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
305	deceased spouse's honorably discharged Marine Corps
306	League license plate until the surviving spouse dies,
307	remarries or does not renew the license plate.

308 (14) The division may issue military organization309 registration plates as follows:

(A) The division may issue a special registration plate for 310 the members of any military organization chartered by the 311 United States Congress upon receipt of a guarantee from the 312 313 organization of a minimum of one hundred applicants. The 314 insignia on the plate shall be designed by the commissioner. 315 (B) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue members of the chartered organization in good standing, as 316 determined by the governing body of the chartered 317 318 organization, a special registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant. 319

320 (C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 321 application fee of \$10 for each special license plate in 322 addition to all other fees required by this chapter. All initial 323 application fees collected by the division shall be deposited 324 into the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this 325 section may be construed to exempt any veteran from any 326 other provision of this chapter.

327 (D) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
328 deceased spouse's military organization registration plate
329 until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew
330 the special military organization registration plate.

(15) The division may issue special nongame wildlife
registration plates and special wildlife registration plates as
follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
a special registration plate displaying a species of West
Virginia wildlife which shall display a species of wildlife
native to West Virginia as prescribed and designated by the
commissioner and the Director of the Division of Natural
Resources.

(B) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for
each special nongame wildlife registration plate and each
special wildlife registration plate in addition to all other fees
required by this chapter. All annual fees collected for
nongame wildlife registration plates and wildlife registration

345	plates shall be deposited in a special revenue account
346	designated the Nongame Wildlife Fund and credited to the
347	Division of Natural Resources.
348	(C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
349	application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
350	this chapter. All initial application fees collected by the
351	division shall be deposited in the State Road Fund.
352	(16) The division may issue members of the Silver Haired
353	Legislature special registration plates as follows:
354	(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
355	to any person who is a duly qualified member of the Silver
356	Haired Legislature a specialized registration plate which
357	bears recognition of the applicant as a member of the Silver

358 Haired Legislature.

(B) A qualified member of the Silver Haired Legislature
may obtain one registration plate described in this
subdivision for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name
of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge an

annual fee of \$15, in addition to all other fees required by
this chapter, for the plate. All annual fees collected by the
division shall be deposited in the State Road Fund.

(17) Upon appropriate application, the commissioner
shall issue to a classic motor vehicle or classic motorcycle as
defined in section three-a, article ten of this chapter, a special
registration plate designed by the commissioner. An annual
fee of \$15, in addition to all other fees required by this
chapter, shall be charged for each classic registration plate.

372 (18) Honorably discharged veterans may be issued
373 special registration plates for motorcycles subject to Class G
374 registration as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued to
any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the armed
services of the United States a special registration plate for
any number of motorcycles subject to Class G registration
titled in the name of the qualified applicant with an insignia
designed by the Commissioner of the Division of Motor
Vehicles.

382	(B) A special initial application fee of \$10 shall be
383	charged in addition to all other fees required by law. This
384	special fee is to be collected by the division and deposited in
385	the State Road Fund: Provided, That nothing in this section
386	may be construed to exempt any veteran from any other
387	provision of this chapter.
388	(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
389	deceased spouse's honorably discharged veterans license

392	(19) Racing theme special registration plates:
393	(A) The division may issue a series of special registration
394	plates displaying National Association for Stock Car Auto

396	(B) An annual fee of \$25 shall be charged for each
397	special racing theme registration plate in addition to all other
398	fees required by this chapter. All annual fees collected for

each special racing theme registration plate shall be deposited

400 into the State Road Fund.

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401 (C) A special application fee of \$10 shall be charged at 402 the time of initial application as well as upon application for 403 any duplicate or replacement registration plate, in addition to 404 all other fees required by this chapter. All application fees 405 shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

406 (20) The division may issue recipients of the Navy Cross,
407 Distinguished Service Cross, Distinguished Flying Cross, Air
408 Force Cross, Bronze Star, Silver Star or Air Medal special
409 registration plates as follows:

410 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to any recipient of the Navy Cross, Distinguished Service 411 Cross, Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver 412 Star, Bronze Star or Air Medal, a registration plate for any 413 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified 414 415 applicant bearing letters or numbers. A separate registration 416 plate shall be designed by the Commissioner of Motor 417 Vehicles for each award that denotes that those individuals 418 who are granted this special registration plate are recipients 419 of the Navy Cross, Distinguished Service Cross,

420 Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver Star or421 Bronze Star, or Air Medal as applicable.

422 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application 423 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This 424 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in 425 the State Road Fund: *Provided*, That nothing in this section 426 exempts the applicant for a special registration plate under 427 this subdivision from any other provision of this chapter.

428 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
429 deceased spouse's Navy Cross, Distinguished Service Cross,
430 Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Force Cross, Silver Star,
431 Bronze Star or Air Medal special registration plate until the
432 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
433 special registration plate.

434 (21) The division may issue honorably discharged435 veterans special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the
armed services of the United States with verifiable service

during World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, the 439 Persian Gulf War or the War Against Terrorism a special 440 441 registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the 442 name of the qualified applicant with an insignia designed by 443 the commissioner denoting service in the applicable conflict. 444 (B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 445 application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by 446 law. This special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the State Road Fund: Provided, That nothing 447 448 contained in this section may be construed to exempt any 449 veteran from any other provision of this chapter.

450 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
451 deceased spouse's honorably discharged veterans registration
452 plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not
453 renew the special registration plate.

454 (22) The division may issue special volunteer firefighter455 registration plates as follows:

456 (A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of457 West Virginia and who is a volunteer firefighter may apply

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458 for a special license plate for any Class A vehicle titled in 459 the name of the qualified applicant which bears the insignia 460 of the profession in white letters on a red background. The 461 insignia shall be designed by the commissioner and shall 462 contain a fireman's helmet insignia on the left side of the

463 license plate.

464 (B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by 465 466 the applicant's fire chief, stating that the applicant is a volunteer firefighter and justified in having a registration 467 468 plate with the requested insignia. The applicant must comply with all other laws of this state regarding 469 470 registration and licensure of motor vehicles and must pay all required fees. 471

472 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this
473 subdivision shall be accompanied by payment of a special
474 one-time initial application fee of \$10, which is in addition
475 to any other registration or license fee required by this

476 chapter. All application fees shall be deposited into the477 State Road Fund.

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478 (23) The division may issue special registration plates
479 which reflect patriotic themes, including the display of any
480 United States symbol, icon, phrase or expression which
481 evokes patriotic pride or recognition.

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
to an applicant a registration plate of the applicant's choice,
displaying a patriotic theme as provided in this subdivision,
for a vehicle titled in the name of the applicant. A series of
registration plates displaying patriotic themes shall be
designed by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles for
distribution to applicants.

(B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by
law. This special fee shall be collected by the division and
deposited in the State Road Fund.

493 (24) Special license plates bearing the American flag and494 the logo "9/11/01".

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue 495 496 special registration plates which shall display the American flag and the logo "9/11/01". 497 498 (B) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate 499 in addition to all other fees required by this chapter. 500 (C) A special application fee of \$10 shall be charged at the time of initial application as well as upon application for 501 502 any duplicate or replacement registration plate, in addition to all other fees required by this chapter. All application fees 503 504 shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

505 (25) The division may issue a special registration plate 506 celebrating the centennial of the 4-H youth development 507 movement and honoring the Future Farmers of America 508 organization as follows:

509 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue 510 a special registration plate depicting the symbol of the 4-H 511 organization which represents the head, heart, hands and 512 health as well as the symbol of the Future Farmers of 513 America organization which represents a cross section of an

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ear of corn for any number of vehicles titled in the name ofthe qualified applicant.

(B) The division shall charge a special initial application
fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in
the State Road Fund.

(C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for
each special 4-H Future Farmers of America registration
plate in addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

(26) The division may issue special registration plates to
educators in the state's elementary and secondary schools
and in the state's institutions of higher education as follows:
(A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue
a special registration plate designed by the commissioner for
any number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified
applicant.

(B) The division shall charge a special initial applicationfee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This

special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in 532 533 the State Road Fund.

(C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for 534 535 each special educator registration plate in addition to all other 536 fees required by this chapter.

(27) The division may issue special registration plates to 537 members of the Nemesis Shrine as follows: 538

539 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue a special registration plate designed by the commissioner for 540 541 any number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified 542 applicant. 1130 (E) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for

1131 each special registration plate in addition to all other fees1132 required by this chapter.

(F) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue
a special registration plate designed by the commissioner in
consultation with the organization for any number of vehicles
titled in the name of a qualified registration plate applicant.
Persons desiring the special registration plate shall offer
sufficient proof of membership in the organization.

(G) The commissioner shall discontinue the issuance or
renewal of the registration of any special plate issued
pursuant to this subdivision (60) if:

(i) The number of valid registrations for the specialty
plate falls below two hundred fifty plates for at least twelve
consecutive months; or

(ii) The organization no longer exists or no longer meetsthe requirements of this subdivision.

1147 (61) The commissioner may issue special registration

1148 plates stating "I Support Veterans" for persons desiring those

1149 plates, as follows:

- 1150 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue
- 1151 a special registration plate designed by the commissioner in
- 1152 cooperation with the Secretary of the Office of Veterans'
- 1153 Assistance for any number of vehicles titled in the name of

- 1155 (B) The division shall charge a special initial application
- 1156 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
- 1157 special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in
- 1158 the State Road Fund.
- 1159 (C) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for
- 1160 each special registration plate in addition to all other fees
- 1161 required by this chapter.
- 1162 (62) The commissioner may issue special registration
- 1163 plates to a resident next-of-kin of a member of any law-
- 1164 enforcement agency of the United States or this state killed
- 1165 <u>in line of duty as follows:</u>
- 1166 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue
- 1167 a special registration plate designed by the commissioner
- 1168 after consultation with the West Virginia Chiefs of Police

1169	Association, the West Virginia Sheriffs' Association, the
1170	West Virginia Troopers Association or the Division of
1171	Natural Resources for any number of vehicles titled in the
1172	name of a qualified applicant.
1173	(B) The next-of-kin shall provide sufficient proof of
1174	eligibility and relationship as required by the commissioner.
1175	(C) The division shall charge a special initial application
1176	fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law. This
1177	special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in
1178	the State Road Fund.
1179	(D) The division shall charge an annual fee of \$15 for
1180	each special registration plate in addition to all other fees
1181	required by this chapter.
1182	(E) The provisions of subsection (d) of this section are
1183	not applicable for the issuance of the special license plates
1184	designated by this subdivision.
1185	(d) The minimum number of applications required prior
1186	to design and production of a special license plate shall be as
1187	follows:

(1) The commissioner may not begin the design or 1188 1189 production of any license plates for which eligibility is based 1190 on membership or affiliation with a particular private 1191 organization until at least one hundred persons complete an 1192 application and deposit with the organization a check to 1193 cover the first year's basic registration, one-time design and 1194 manufacturing costs and to cover the first year additional 1195 annual fee. If the organization fails to submit the required number of applications with attached checks within six 1196 1197 months of the effective date of the original authorizing 1198 legislation, the plate will not be produced and will require 1199 legislative reauthorization: *Provided*, That an organization or group that is unsuccessful in obtaining the minimum 1200 number of applications may not request reconsideration of a 1201

special plate until at least two years have passed since the
effective date of the original authorization: *Provided*, *however*, That the provisions of this subdivision (1) are not
applicable to the issuance of plates authorized pursuant to

1206 subdivision (60) subdivisions (60) and (62), subsection (c) of1207 this section.

(2) The commissioner may not begin the design or 1208 1209 production of any license plates authorized by this section for which membership or affiliation with a particular 1210 1211 organization is not required until at least two hundred fifty 1212 registrants complete an application and deposit a fee with the 1213 division to cover the first year's basic registration fee, one-1214 time design and manufacturing fee and additional annual fee 1215 if applicable. If the commissioner fails to receive the required number of applications within six months of the 1216 1217 effective date of the original authorizing legislation, the plate 1218 will not be produced and will require legislative 1219 reauthorization: Provided, That if the minimum number of 1220 applications is not satisfied within the six months of the 1221 effective date of the original authorizing legislation, a person may not request reconsideration of a special plate until at 1222 least two years have passed since the effective date of the 1223 1224 original authorization.

(e) (1) Nothing in this section requires a charge for a free
prisoner of war license plate or a free recipient of the
Congressional Medal of Honor license plate for a vehicle
titled in the name of the qualified applicant as authorized by
other provisions of this code.

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(2) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's prisoner of war license plate or
Congressional Medal of Honor license plate until the
surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
license plate.

(3) Qualified former prisoners of war and recipients of
the Congressional Medal of Honor may obtain a second
special registration plate for use on a passenger vehicle titled
in the name of the qualified applicant. The division shall
charge a one-time fee of \$10 to be deposited into the State
Road Fund, in addition to all other fees required by this
chapter, for the second special plate.

1242 (f) The division may issue special ten-year registration1243 plates as follows:

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1244 (1) The commissioner may issue or renew for a period of 1245 no more than ten years any registration plate exempted from registration fees pursuant to any provision of this code or any 1246 restricted use antique motor vehicle license plate authorized 1247 1248 by section three-a, article ten of this chapter: Provided, That 1249 the provisions of this subsection do not apply to any person who has had a special registration suspended for failure to 1250 1251 maintain motor vehicle liability insurance as required by section three, article two-a, chapter seventeen-d of this code 1252 1253 or failure to pay personal property taxes as required by 1254 section three-a of this article.

(2) An initial nonrefundable fee shall be charged for each
special registration plate issued pursuant to this subsection,
which is the total amount of fees required by section fifteen,
article ten of this chapter, section three, article three of this
chapter or section three-a, article ten of this chapter for the
period requested.

(g) The provisions of this section may not be construedto exempt any registrant from maintaining motor vehicle

liability insurance as required by section three, article two-a,
chapter seventeen-d of this code or from paying personal
property taxes on any motor vehicle as required by section
three-a of this article.

1267 (h) The commissioner may, in his or her discretion, issue 1268 a registration plate of reflectorized material suitable for permanent use on motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers, 1269 together with appropriate devices to be attached to the 1270 registration to indicate the year for which the vehicles have 1271 been properly registered or the date of expiration of the 1272 registration. The design and expiration of the plates shall be 1273 determined by the commissioner. The commissioner shall, 1274 whenever possible and cost effective, implement the latest 1275 technology in the design, production and issuance of 1276 1277 registration plates, indices of registration renewal and vehicle ownership documents, including, but not limited to, offering 1278 Internet renewal of vehicle registration and the use of bar 1279 codes for instant identification of vehicles by scanning 1280 1281 equipment to promote the efficient and effective coordination

1282	and communication of data for improving highway safety,
1283	aiding law enforcement and enhancing revenue collection.
1284	(i) Any license plate issued or renewed pursuant to this
1285	chapter which is paid for by a check that is returned for
1286	nonsufficient funds is void without further notice to the
1287	applicant. The applicant may not reinstate the registration
1288	until the returned check is paid by the applicant in cash,
1289	money order or certified check and all applicable fees
1290	assessed as a result thereof have been paid.
