## Senate Bill No. 347

(By Senators Snyder, Miller, Green, Sypolt, Unger and Fitzsimmons)

[Originating in the Committee on the Judiciary; reported April 1, 2013.]

A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §6C-3-2a, relating to requiring the Public Employees Grievance Board in conjunction with the Division of Personnel to provide training seminars for chief administrators and persons who conduct level one hearings and conferences under the public employees' grievance process; stating certain training requirements; requiring chief administrators and persons who conduct level one hearings and conferences to obtain certain training; and permitting a registration fee for the training. *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*  Eng. Com. Sub. for S. B. No. 347] 2

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §6C-3-2a, to read as follows:

# ARTICLE 3. WEST VIRGINIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES GRIEVANCE BOARD.

### §6C-3-2a. Level one hearing and conference training seminars.

Public Employees Grievance (a) The Board, in conjunction with the Division of Personnel, shall provide at least one training seminar each year for chief 1 administrators and persons who conduct level one hearings 2 and conferences, under the provisions of article two of this 3 chapter, to help ensure level one hearings and conferences 4 are being conducted in a uniform manner. The Public 5 Employees Grievance Board, in conjunction with the 6 Division of Personnel, shall also create a version of the 7 training appropriate for teaching over the Internet and place 8 the training on the Public Employees Grievance Board 9 website

- (b) Each training seminar shall include instruction onthe following:
- 13 (1) The time limits involved in a grievance;
- 14 (2) The process and procedure for each level of the15 grievance procedure;
- 16 (3) The rights of participants in the grievance procedure;
- 17 (4) Writing the decision; and
- 18 (5) Any other topic the Public Employees Grievance
  19 Board or the Division of Personnel determine necessary or
  20 informative.

(c) On and after January 1, 2014, all chief administrators
and persons who conduct level one hearings and conferences,
under the provisions of article two of this chapter, shall have
attended a training seminar provided in accordance with this
section.

(d) A newly appointed chief administrator and a
newly appointed person who conducts level one hearings
and conferences, under the provisions of article two of this
chapter, shall attend the training seminar prior to conducting

level one hearings and conferences: *Provided*, That a newly 30 appointed chief administrator or a newly appointed person 31 who conducts level one hearings and conferences may 32 conduct a level one hearing or conference if, prior to the 33 level one hearing or conference, the person both completes 34 35 the online version of the training authorized by subsection 36 (a) of this section and agrees to complete the full training the next time the full training is offered. 37

(e) The Public Employees Grievance Board and the
Division of Personnel may charge a registration fee for the
training seminar to cover the cost of providing the training
seminar.

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
