A BILL to amend and reenact §20-2-32 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to issuing hunting and fishing licenses; and clarifying who may be designated a license-issuing authority.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §20-2-32 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.

§20-2-32. Issuance of licenses; duplicate licenses.

- 1 (a) The <u>director may designate the</u> clerk of the county
- 2 commission in each county and or other persons, designated
- 3 by the director shall be pursuant to section thirty-three of this
- 4 <u>article</u>, as license-issuing authorities Each license-issuing
- 5 authority shall issue authorized to issue a license to a license
- 6 an applicant if in the opinion of the authority, the license
- 7 applicant is legally entitled to obtain the license applied for
- 8 and pays the proper fee.
- 9 (b) All Materials and supplies necessary for the issuance
- 10 of licenses shall be furnished by the director to each person
- 11 authorized to issue licenses license-issuing authority as
- 12 needed.
- 13 (c) Each license shall bear a serial number and shall be
- 14 signed by the licensee. The issuing license-issuing authority
- 15 shall keep an accurate record in the form and manner
- 16 prescribed by the director, of all licenses issued and of all
- 17 money fees collected as license fees as prescribed by the
- 18 director.

- 19 (d) Any license-issuing authority may issue a duplicate
- 20 license to replace a lost, destroyed or damaged license upon
- 21 receipt of a verified application duly executed by the original
- 22 license holder licensee and the payment to the issuing
- 23 authority of a duplicate license fee of \$1.

(NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to update the law pertaining to the issuance of hunting and fishing licenses. It clarifies who are license issuing authorities.
