A BILL to amend and reenact §18-5-32 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to including substitute teaching in the job duties of certain professional educators employed by county boards of education in certain administrative and supervisory positions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §18-5-32 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5. COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

§18-5-32. Assistant superintendents; directors and supervisors of instruction and other educational activities.

- 1 (a) The county board, upon the recommendation of the
- 2 county superintendent, may employ an assistant whose term
- 3 of employment shall may be not less than one nor more than
- 4 four years: Provided, That his or her term shall may not
- 5 extend beyond that of the incumbent county superintendent.
- 6 (b) The board shall may not employ more than one
- 7 assistant for each two hundred teachers or major fraction
- 8 thereof.
- 9 (c) The county board, upon the recommendation of the
- 10 county superintendent, is authorized to employ general and
- 11 special supervisors or directors of instruction and of other
- 12 educational activities as may be considered necessary.
- 13 (d) The employment of the assistant superintendent shall
- 14 be on a twelve-month basis. The period of employment for
- 15 all others named herein shall be at the discretion of the
- 16 county board.

- 17 (e) Rules for qualifications of assistant superintendents,
- 18 and directors and supervisors of instruction and of other
- 19 educational activities shall be fixed by the state board:
- 20 Provided, That the qualifications required for any assistant
- 21 superintendent shall in no event may not be higher than those
- 22 required for the county superintendent: *Provided, however,*
- 23 That the rules do not affect the status of any incumbent nor
- 24 his or her right to succeed himself or herself in his or her
- 25 assigned position.
- 26 (f) The county board of education is authorized to
- 27 reimburse the employees for their necessary traveling
- 28 expenses upon presentation of a monthly, itemized, sworn
- 29 statement approved by the county superintendent.
- 30 (g) Any person employed under the foregoing provision
- 31 of this section, provided he or she holds a valid teacher's
- 32 certificate, shall be given continuing contract status as a
- 33 teacher and shall hold that status unless dismissed for
- 34 statutory reasons.

- (h) The job duties of a professional educator employed 35 under the provisions of this section, including a professional 36 educator employed as a "supervisor" or "central office 37 administrator" as defined in section one, article one, chapter 38 eighteen-a of this code, shall include substitute teaching on 39 at least three instructional days each school year: Provided, 40 That the substitute teaching requirement of this subsection 41 does not apply to the superintendent and those who have 42 never held a teaching certificate or an administrative 43 certificate. 44
- 45 (h) (i) All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 46 section are hereby repealed.
