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9 A BILL to amend and reenact §19-12A-6a of the Code of West
10 Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to increasing the annual
11 cap for collections into the Land Division special revenue
12 account of the Department of Agriculture; and depositing half
13 of any excess funds collected into the special revenue account
14 and half into the General Revenue Fund.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That §19-12A-6a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
17 amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 12A. LAND DIVISION.**

19 **§19-12A-6a. Special revenue account.**

20 (a) All funds collected by the commission ~~by virtue of~~
21 pursuant to this article, whether from the sale of food, the
22 disposition of assets other than land, the lease of land or
23 minerals or any other source, shall be paid into a special revenue
24 account to be used for the purposes of this article. *Provided,*

1 That when the aggregate of said funds so collected and deposited in
2 the special revenue account in any fiscal year total ~~\$1,500,000~~
3 \$2,000,000, the commission shall deposit half of any excess funds
4 collected into the special revenue account, and half into ~~any funds~~
5 ~~collected in excess thereof~~ in the General Revenue Fund of the
6 state.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase the cap for collections into the Land Division special revenue account of the Department of Agriculture from \$1.5 million to \$2 million and to divide amounts in excess of the cap evenly between the special revenue account and the General Revenue Fund of the State.
