15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
17	by adding thereto a new section, designated $\$46A-6-111$, to read as
18	follows:
19	ARTICLE 6. GENERAL CONSUMER PROTECTION.
20	§46A-6-111. Waiver of jury trial in claims arising from consumer
21	transactions.
22	An agreement wherein a consumer, in connection with a consumer
23	transaction, prospectively waives his or her right to a jury trial
24	in favor of mandatory arbitration on all claims or causes of action

- 1 arising from such consumer transaction, is enforceable against the
- 2 consumer: Provided, That such agreement (a) is memorialized and
- 3 executed on a separate document, standing alone from other
- 4 documents pertaining to the relevant consumer transaction, and (b)
- 5 makes clear by conspicuous language that the waiver of trial by
- 6 jury specifically includes, but is not limited to, claims or causes
- 7 of action involving personal injury, property damage and death.
