19	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
20	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended

23	ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL STATE BOARDS OF
24	EXAMINATION OR REGISTRATION REFERRED TO IN CHAPTER.

25 §30-1-20. Certain boards to regulating health care professions to

- qather retirement information and include in annual reports.
