

Senate Bill No. 108

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee
on Government Organization; and then to the Committee on the
Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Board of Dental Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule
relating to practitioner requirements for accessing the West
Virginia Controlled Substances Monitoring Program database.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Dental Examiners.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 22,
2013, authorized under the authority of section five-a, article

1 nine, chapter sixty-a of this code, modified by the Board of Dental
2 Examiners to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making
3 Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 31,
4 2013, relating to the Board of Dental Examiners (practitioner
5 requirements for accessing the West Virginia controlled substances
6 monitoring program database, [5 CSR 10](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
Dental Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
Practitioner Requirements for Accessing the West Virginia
Controlled Substances Monitoring Program Database.
