

**Senate Bill No. 117**

(By Senator Snyder)

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[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee on Health and Human Resources; then to the Committee on Government Organization; and then to the Committee on the Judiciary.]

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A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to controlled substances monitoring.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.**

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on October 18, 2013, authorized under the authority of section six, article

1 nine, chapter sixty-a of this code, modified by the Board of  
2 Pharmacy to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making  
3 Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 20,  
4 2013, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (controlled substances  
5 monitoring, [15 CSR 8](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Controlled Substances Monitoring.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
