

Senate Bill No. 123

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee
on Government Organization; and then to the Committee on the
Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology
to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the licensure of
speech-language pathology and audiology.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and
Audiology.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25,
2 2013, authorized under the authority of section seven, article
3 thirty-two, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of
4 Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology to meet the
5 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
6 refiled in the State Register on December 18, 2013, relating to the
7 Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology
8 (licensure of speech-pathology and audiology, [29 CSR 1](#)), is
9 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the licensure of speech-pathology and audiology.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
