

Senate Bill No. 125

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee
on Government Organization; and then to the Committee on the
Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology
to promulgate a legislative rule relating to disciplinary and
complaint procedures for speech-language pathology and
audiology.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and

2 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25,
3 2013, authorized under the authority of section seven, article
4 thirty-two, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of
5 Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology to meet the
6 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
7 refiled in the State Register on November 26, 2013, relating to the
8 Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology
9 (disciplinary and complaint procedures for speech-language
10 pathology and audiology, [29 CSR 4](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology to promulgate a legislative rule relating to disciplinary and complaint procedures for speech-language pathology and audiology.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
