

Senate Bill No. 128

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee
on Labor; and then to the Committee on the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to employer wage bonds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR BUREAU OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-10-1. Division of Labor.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 23, 2013, authorized under the authority of section thirteen, article five, chapter twenty-one of this code, modified by the Division of Labor to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review

1 Committee and refiled in the State Register on November 5, 2013,
2 relating to the Division of Labor (employer wage bonds, [42 CSR 33](#)),
3 is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to employer wage bonds.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
