22	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 22,
23	2013, authorized under the authority of section four, article five,

1 chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the Department of 2 Environmental Protection (standards of performance for new 3 stationary sources, <u>45 CSR 16</u>), is authorized.
