

Senate Bill No. 143

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee on
Economic Development; and then to the Committee on the
Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a
legislative rule relating to voluntary remediation and
redevelopment.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26,
2013, authorized under the authority of section three, article

1 twenty-two, chapter twenty-two of this code, modified by the
2 Department of Environmental Protection to meet the objections of
3 the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the
4 State Register on December 17, 2013, relating to the Department of
5 Environmental Protection (voluntary remediation and redevelopment,
6 [60 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to voluntary remediation and redevelopment.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
