

**Senate Bill No. 145**

(By Senator Snyder)

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[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee on  
Agriculture and Rural Development; and then to the Committee on  
the Judiciary.]

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A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of  
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule  
relating to a schedule of charges for inspection services:  
fruit.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Commissioner of Agriculture.**

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26,  
2013, authorized under the authority of section five, article two,

1 chapter nineteen of this code, modified by the Commissioner of  
2 Agriculture to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making  
3 Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September 30,  
4 2013, relating to the Commissioner of Agriculture (schedule of  
5 charges for inspection services: fruit, [61 CSR 8B](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to a schedule of charges for inspection services: fruit.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
