A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to AIDS-related medical testing and confidentiality.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.**

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2013, authorized under the authority of section four, article one,

1 chapter sixteen of this code, modified by the Department of Health  
2 and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-  
3 Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
4 December 9, 2013, relating to the Department of Health and Human  
5 Resources (AIDs-related medical testing and confidentiality, [64 CSR](#)  
6 [64](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to AIDS-related Medical Testing and Confidentiality.
