

Senate Bill No. 156

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee on
 Government Organization; and then to the Committee on the
 Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 6, chapter 64 of the Code of
 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
 Fire Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 the State Fire Code.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 6, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND
 PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-6-1. Fire Commission.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on June 19,
2013, authorized under the authority of section five, article
three, chapter twenty-nine of this code, modified by the Fire

1 Commission to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making
2 Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 3,
3 2013, relating to the Fire Commission (State Fire Code, [87 CSR 1](#)),
4 is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Fire Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the State Fire Code.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
