A BILL to amend and reenact article 8, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Office of Administrative Hearings to promulgate a legislative rule relating to appeal procedures.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article 8, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 8. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-8-1. Office of Administrative Hearings.**

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2013, authorized under the authority of section four-a, article five-c, chapter seventeen-c of this code, modified by the Office of Administrative Hearings to meet the objections of the Legislative

1 Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
2 December 19, 2013, relating to the Office of Administrative  
3 Hearings (appeal procedures, [105 CSR 1](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Administrative Hearings to promulgate a legislative rule relating to appeal procedures.
