

Senate Bill No. 190

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee on
Agriculture and Rural Development; and then to the Committee on
the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to promulgate a
legislative rule relating to the sale of wine.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TAX AND REVENUE TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-7-1. Alcohol Beverage Control Commission.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26,
2013, authorized under the authority of section twenty-three,
article eight, chapter sixty of this code, modified by the Alcohol

1 Beverage Control Commission to meet the objections of the
2 Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State
3 Register on October 31, 2013, relating to the Alcohol Beverage
4 Commission (sale of wine, [175 CSR 4](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Alcohol Beverage Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Sale of Wine.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
