

Senate Bill No. 197

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee on Pensions; then to the Committee on Finance; and then to the Committee on the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Municipal Pensions Oversight Board to promulgate a legislative rule relating to policemen's and firemen's pensions disability calculation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Municipal Pensions Oversight Board.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2013, authorized under the authority of section eighteen-a, article

1 two, chapter eight of this code, modified by the Municipal Pensions
2 Oversight Board to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-
3 Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
4 November 25, 2013, relating to the Municipal Pensions Oversight
5 Board (policemen's and firemen's pensions disability calculation,
6 [211 CSR 1](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Municipal Pensions Oversight Board to promulgate a legislative rule relating to policemen's and firemen's pensions disability calculation.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
