L1	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$18-2-25$ of the Code of West Virginia,
L2	1931, as amended, relating to requiring the West Virginia
L3	Secondary School Activities Commission to promulgate rules
L 4	that allow a college preparatory team to elect to be
L 5	recognized as a member; and setting forth provisions the rule
L 6	shall include.
L 7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
L 8	That $$18-2-25$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
L 9	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
20	ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.
21	§18-2-25. Authority of county boards to regulate athletic and
22	other extracurricular activities of secondary schools;
23	delegation of authority to West Virginia Secondary
24	School Activities Commission; authority of commission;

- approval of rules and regulations by state board;
 incorporation; funds; participation by private and
 parochial schools.
- 4 (a) The county boards of education are hereby granted and 5 shall exercise the control, supervision and regulation of all 6 interscholastic athletic events, and other extracurricular 7 activities of the students in public secondary schools, and of said 8 schools of their respective counties. The county board of 9 education may delegate such control, supervision and regulation of 10 interscholastic athletic events and band activities to the West 11 Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, which is hereby 12 established.
- (b) The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission

 14 shall be composed of the principals, or their representatives, of

 15 those secondary schools whose county boards of education have

 16 certified in writing to the State Superintendent of Schools that

 17 they have elected to delegate the control, supervision and

 18 regulation of their interscholastic athletic events and band

 19 activities of the students in the public secondary schools in their

 20 respective counties to said commission. The West Virginia

 21 Secondary School Activities Commission is hereby empowered to

 22 exercise the control, supervision and regulation of interscholastic

 23 athletic events and band activities of secondary schools, delegated

 24 to it pursuant to this section. The rules and regulations of the

1 West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall contain 2 a provision for a proper review procedure and review board and be 3 promulgated in accordance with the provisions of 4 twenty-nine-a of this code, but shall, in all instances, be subject 5 to the prior approval of the state board. The West Virginia 6 Secondary School Activities Commission, may, with the consent of 7 the State Board of Education, incorporate under the name of West 8 Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, Inc., as a 9 nonprofit, nonstock corporation under the provisions of chapter 10 thirty-one of this code. County boards of education are hereby 11 authorized to expend moneys for and pay dues to the West Virginia 12 Secondary School Activities Commission, and all moneys paid to such 13 the commission, as well as moneys derived from any contest or other 14 event sponsored by said commission, shall be quasi-public funds as 15 the same are defined in article five, chapter eighteen of this 16 code, and such the funds of the commission shall be subject to an 17 annual audit by the State Tax Commissioner.

(c) The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall promulgate reasonable rules and regulations providing for the control, supervision and regulation of the interscholastic athletic events and other extracurricular activities of such private and parochial secondary schools as elect to delegate to such the commission such control, supervision and regulation, upon the same terms and conditions, subject to the same regulations and

- 1 requirements and upon the payment of the same fees and charges as
- 2 those provided for public secondary schools. Any such private or
- 3 parochial secondary school shall receive any monetary or other
- 4 benefits in the same manner and in the same proportion as any
- 5 public secondary school.
- 6 (d) The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission
- 7 shall promulgate reasonable rules pursuant to this section that
- 8 allow a college preparatory team to elect to be recognized as a
- 9 member of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission.
- 10 The rules shall:
- 11 (1) Limit recognition of college preparatory teams as members
- 12 of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission to only
- 13 those college preparatory teams that require its students to attend
- 14 a school which has elected to delegate control pursuant to
- 15 subsections (b) and (c) of this section and that require all of its
- 16 students to attend the same school;
- 17 (2) Prohibit a college preparatory team recognized as a member
- 18 of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission from
- 19 competing for league, regional or state championships;
- 20 (3) Prohibit a college preparatory team recognized as a member
- 21 of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission from
- 22 having fifth-year seniors or post-high school graduate student
- 23 athletes on its roster; and
- 24 (4) Require a college preparatory team recognized as a member

- 1 of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission to play
- 2 <u>a limited schedule in each sanctioned sport against schools that</u>
- 3 have elected to delegate control pursuant to subsections (b) and
- 4 (c) of this section.
