(b) Subject to the provisions of section four of this article,

4 an owner of land who either directly or indirectly invites or

5 permits without charge, as that term is defined in section five of

6 this article, any person to use such his or her property for

7 recreational or wildlife propagation purposes does not thereby:

8 (a) (1) Extend any assurance that the premises are safe for any

9 purpose; or (b) (2) confer upon such persons the legal status of an

10 invitee or licensee to whom a duty of care is owed; or (c) (3)

11 assume responsibility for or incur liability for any injury to

12 person or property caused by an act or omission of such the

13 persons; or (4) assume responsibility for or incur liability for

14 any injury to person or property, wherever the person or property

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to limit a landowner's civil liability for injuries that may occur to person or property on the landowner's property or surrounding property while hunting.
