A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Bureau for Child Support Enforcement to promulgate a
legislative rule relating to the Bureau.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-5-1. Bureau for Child Support Enforcement.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 29,
2013, authorized under the authority of section one hundred five,
article eighteen, chapter forty-eight of this code, modified by the
Bureau for Child Support Enforcement to meet the objections of the

1 Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State
2 Register on December 18, 2013, relating to the Bureau for Child
3 Support Enforcement (the Bureau for Child Support Enforcement, [97](#)
4 [CSR 1](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Bureau for Child Support Enforcement to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Bureau.
