A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Board of Dental Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule
relating to practitioner requirements for accessing the West
Virginia controlled substances monitoring program database.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia,
1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Dental Examiners.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 22,
2013, authorized under the authority of section five-a, article
nine, chapter sixty-a of this code, modified by the Board of Dental
