A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a
legislative rule relating to AIDs-related medical testing and
confidentiality.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN
RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25,
2013, authorized under the authority of section four, article one,
chapter sixteen of this code, modified by the Department of Health

1 and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-
2 Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
3 December 9, 2013, relating to the Department of Health and Human
4 Resources (AIDs-related medical testing and confidentiality, [64 CSR](#)
5 [64](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to AIDS-related Medical Testing and Confidentiality.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
