910 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Treasurer's Office to promulgate a legislative rule relating
13 to providing services to political subdivisions.14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*15 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:17 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
18 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**19 **§64-9-1. Treasurer's Office.**20 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26,
21 2013, authorized under the authority of section six, article three-
22 a, chapter twelve of this code, modified by the Treasurer's Office
23 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review

1 Committee and refiled in the State Register on November 12, 2013,
2 relating to the Treasurer's Office (providing services to political
3 subdivisions, [112 CSR 13](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Treasurer's Office to promulgate a legislative rule relating to providing services to political subdivisions.
