15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
17	by adding thereto a new section, designated $\$30-7-21$, to read as
18	follows:
19	ARTICLE 7A. PRACTICAL NURSES.
20	\$30-7-21. Federal background check by name search permitted if two
21	sets of fingerprints rejected as unreadable.
22	<u>A person seeking to be licensed as a registered professional</u>
23	nurse may have the required federal background check completed
24	based on a name search after two sets of fingerprints have been
25	rejected as unreadable.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit the federal background check mandated for licensing registered professional nurses to be completed based on a name search after two sets of fingerprints have been rejected as unreadable.
