

1 ~~upon or~~ within designated municipal parking areas and upon
2 municipal streets. Parking enforcement officers may sign complaints
3 and issue citations.

4 (b) Parking enforcement officers shall:

5 (1) Be in uniform;

6 (2) Display a badge or other sign of authority; and

7 (3) Serve at the will and pleasure of their employer.

8 (c) The governing body of the municipality may require the
9 parking enforcement officers to give a surety bond, payable to the
10 municipality. The governing body shall set the amount of the bond
11 conditioned for the faithful performance of their duties. Nothing
12 in this section may be construed to mean that parking enforcement
13 officers come within the civil service provisions of this article
14 or the policemen's pension and relief fund provisions of article
15 twenty-two of this chapter.

16 (d) No parking enforcement officers or any other law-
17 enforcement officials may ticket a vehicle parked at a broken
18 parking meter, unless the municipality clearly marks the meter with
19 a sign prohibiting parking.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the ticketing of vehicles parked at broken parking meters.
