10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
11	adding thereto a new section, designated §29-3-5e, relating to
12	requiring the construction of new public buildings and when an
13	entrance of an existing public building is renovated to be
14	compliant with the federal Americans With Disabilities Act by
15	having automatic doors; and defining a term.
16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
17	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
18	by adding thereto a new section, designated \$29-3-5e, to read as
19	follows:
20	ARTICLE 3. FIRE PREVENTION AND CONTROL ACT.
21	§29-3-5e. Promulgation of rules for public buildings;
22	construction; renovation; automatic doors.
23	(a) The State Fire Commission shall propose rules for
24	legislative approval in accordance with article three, chapter
25	twenty-nine-a of this code to ensure the construction of new public

- 1 buildings and public buildings whose entrances are renovated
- 2 throughout this state are handicap accessible by the use of
- 3 automatic doors.
- 4 (b) The rules shall comply with the standards set forth in the
- 5 federal Americans With Disabilities Act, including, but not limited

- 7 (1) Door openings must provide at least a thirty-two inch

- 9 (2) Designed so that no more than five pounds of force is
- 10 required to open or close the door and must take at least three

- 15 <u>(c) For the purposes of this section the term "public</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the construction of new public buildings and when an entrance to an existing public building is renovated to be compliant with the federal Americans With Disabilities Act by having automatic doors. The bill defines the term "public building."

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
