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10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$5-13-2$ and $\$5-13-4$ of the Code of West	
11	Virginia, 1931, as amended, all relating to the Teachers'	
12	Retirement System annuity calculation for reciprocal service	
13	credit; and defining Teachers Final Average Salary; and	
14	providing procedure for annuity calculation for reciprocal

16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:	
17	That $\$5-13-2$ and $\$5-13-4$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,	
18	as amended, be amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:	
19	ARTICLE 13. PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' AND TEACHERS' RECIPROCAL SERVICE	
20	CREDIT ACT.	
21	§5-13-2. Definitions.	
22	The following words and phrases as used in this article,	
23	unless a different meaning is clearly indicated by the context,

1 shall have the following meanings:

2 (a) "State system" means the West Virginia Public Employees
3 Retirement System and the state teachers' retirement system.

4 (b) "Public system" means the West Virginia Public Employees
5 Retirement System.

6 (c) "Teacher system" means the state teachers' retirement 7 system.

8 (d) "Member" means a member of either the West Virginia Public 9 Employees Retirement System or the state teachers' retirement 10 system. The term "member" shall not include any person who has 11 retired under either state system.

12 (e) "Accumulated contributions" means the sum of the amounts 13 deducted from the compensations of a member and credited to his 14 individual account in a state system, together with interest, if 15 any, credited thereto.

(f) "Public final average salary" means a member's final average salary computed according to the law governing the public system. In computing his public final average salary, the compensations, if any, received by him for services rendered in positions covered by the teacher system shall be used in the same manner as if the compensations were received for services covered by the public system.

23 (g) "Teacher average salary" means a member's average salary

1 computed according to the law governing the teacher system. In
2 computing his teacher average salary, the compensations, if any,
3 received by him for services rendered in positions covered by the
4 public system shall be used in the same manner as if the
5 compensations were received for services covered by the teacher
6 system.

7 (h) "Reciprocal service credit" for a member of the public 8 system who subsequently becomes a member of the teacher system, or 9 vice versa, means the sum of his credited service in force acquired 10 as a member of the public system and his credit service in force 11 acquired as a member of the teacher system.

12 (i) "Annuity" means the annuity payable by a state system.

13 <u>(a) "Accumulated contributions" means the sum of the amounts</u> 14 <u>deducted from the compensation of a member and credited to his or</u> 15 <u>her individual account in a state system, together with interest,</u> 16 <u>if any, credited thereto.</u>

(b) "Annuity" means the annuity payable by a state system.
(c) "Member" means a member of either the West Virginia Public

19 <u>Employees Retirement System or the State Teachers Retirement</u> 20 <u>System. The term "member" does not include any person who has</u> 21 <u>retired under either state system.</u>

22 (d) "Public final average salary" means a member's final 23 average salary computed according to the law governing the public

1 system. In computing his or her public final average salary, the
2 compensation, if any, received by the member for services rendered
3 in positions covered by the teacher system shall be used in the
4 same manner as if the compensation were received for services
5 covered by the public system.

6 (e) "Public system" means the West Virginia Public Employees
7 <u>Retirement System established in article ten, chapter five of this</u>
8 <u>code.</u>

9 (f) "Reciprocal service credit" for a member of the public 10 system who subsequently becomes a member of the teacher system, or 11 vice versa, means the sum of his or her credited service in force 12 acquired as a member of the public system and his or her credited 13 service in force acquired as a member of the teacher system.

(g) "State system" means the West Virginia Public Employees
 Retirement System and the State Teachers Retirement System.

16 (h) "Teacher final average salary" means a member's final 17 average salary computed according to the law governing the teacher 18 system. In computing his or her teacher final average salary, the 19 compensation, if any, received by the member for services rendered 20 in positions covered by the public system shall be used in the same 21 manner as if the compensation were received for services covered by 22 the teacher system.

23 (i) "Teacher system" means the State Teachers Retirement

1 System established in article seven-a, chapter eighteen of this
2 code.

3 (j) The masculine gender includes the feminine, and words of 4 the singular number with respect to persons include the plural 5 number, and vice versa.

6 §5-13-4. Reciprocal service.

7 In the event a member leaves a position covered by the public 8 system and within five years thereafter becomes employed in a 9 position covered by the teacher system, or a member leaves the 10 position covered by the teacher system and within five years 11 thereafter becomes employed in a position covered by the public 12 system, in either case, the following provisions shall apply. 13 together with such rules and regulations as the board of trustees 14 of the public system and the retirement board of the teacher system 15 shall from time to time mutually agree upon.

16 (a) A member's reciprocal service credit in force shall be 17 used to satisfy the service requirements for retirement under the 18 state system from which he <u>or she</u> retires.

19 (b) If a member, who has reciprocal service credit in force, 20 retires under the public system, he <u>or she</u> shall receive an annuity 21 payable by the public system and an annuity payable by the teacher 22 system. His <u>or her</u> public system annuity shall be based upon (1) 23 the portion of his <u>or her</u> reciprocal service credit acquired as a

1 member of the public system, and (2) his <u>or her</u> public final 2 average salary. <u>His The member's</u> teacher system annuity shall be 3 based upon: (1) The portion of his <u>or her</u> reciprocal service credit 4 acquired as a member of the teacher system; and (2) his <u>or her</u> 5 teachers' retirement allowance <u>final average salary</u> as provided by 6 the teachers retirement act. His <u>or her</u> teacher system annuity 7 shall begin as of the date he <u>or she</u> retires under the public 8 system, but in no case prior to the date he <u>the member</u> would have 9 been eligible to retire under the teacher system if all his <u>or her</u> 10 reciprocal service credit had been acquired as a member of the 11 teacher system.

(c) If a member, who has reciprocal service credit in force, retires under the teacher system, he <u>or she</u> shall receive an annuity payable by the teacher system and an annuity payable by the public system. His <u>The member's</u> teacher system annuity shall be based upon: (1) The portion of his <u>or her</u> reciprocal service credit racquired as a member of the teacher system; and (2) his <u>or her</u> teachers' retirement allowance <u>final average salary</u> as provided by the teachers retirement act. His <u>or her</u> public system annuity shall be based upon: (1) The portion of <u>his</u> <u>the</u> reciprocal service credit acquired as a member of the public system annuity shall be based upon: (1) The portion of <u>his</u> <u>the</u> reciprocal service credit acquired as a member of the public system; and (2) his <u>or her</u> public final average salary. His <u>or her</u> public system annuity shall be based as of the date he <u>or she</u> retired under the teacher system,

1 but in no case prior to the date he <u>or she</u> would have been eligible
2 to retire under the public system if all his <u>or her</u> reciprocal
3 service credit had been acquired as a member of the public system.
4 The provisions of this section, as amended, shall be

5 retroactive to June eleventh, one thousand nine hundred sixty-five.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to clarify that the TRS annuity calculation for a member with reciprocal service credit shall be based on the final average salary calculation as provided by TRS; to alphabetize the definitions section; and to make technical corrections throughout.
