

1 (b) In order to receive a registration plate under this
2 section the applicant must demonstrate that the applicant:

3 (1) Is a resident spouse, child, grandchild or parent of a
4 member of any West Virginia law-enforcement agency, a firefighter
5 or paramedic killed in the line of duty; and

6 (2) Provides proof of eligibility and relationship required by
7 the commissioner.

8 (c) The commissioner shall design the special plate after
9 consultation with the West Virginia Chiefs of Police Association,
10 the West Virginia Sheriffs' Association, the West Virginia Troopers
11 Association, the West Virginia Firemen's Association and the
12 Division of Natural Resources.

13 (d) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue a
14 special registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the
15 name of a qualified applicant.

16 (e) The division shall charge a special initial application
17 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law for a
18 registration plate issued under this section. The fee shall be
19 collected by the division and deposited in the State Road Fund.

20 (f) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in
21 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

22 (g) The provisions of subsections (a), (b), (g), (h) and (i)
23 of section fourteen of this section apply in the issuance of plates
24 under this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the issuance of special "Family of Fallen Hero" registration plates.
